HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS APPLY ONLINE FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

Complete TTC's online scholarship application between Jan. 25 and April 22, 2022. The college will use your application to determine your eligibility for all TTC scholarships for the 2022-23 academic year.

Before gaining access to the online scholarship application, high school seniors must complete these steps:

- 1) Submit a TTC admission application to the TTC Admissions office. You will receive a TTC student ID number and email account once your application is processed.
- 2) Submit an official high school transcript (through your junior year) to the Admissions office.
- 3) Submit SAT/ACT scores to the Admissions office OR complete the TTC placement test.

Once you complete these steps, you may access the online scholarship application through the my.tridenttech.edu student portal.

From the main menu, click on "Financial Life," then "My Financial Aid," and then "2022-23 TTC Online Scholarship Application," under 2022/23 TTC Scholarship Application.
