NEWBERRY COLLEGE AND KINGSTREE HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL PROGRAMS HONOR THE LEGACY OF MYCHEAL EDWARDS WALLACE WITH HELMET TRIBUTE

The Newberry College football program and Kingstree High School football program are honoring the life and legacy of Mycheal Edwards Wallace, a former Kingstree High School Blazers athlete whose life was tragically taken by gun violence earlier this summer. Newberry College recruited Mycheal to play football this Fall.

In a heartfelt tribute, players from Newberry College and Kingstree High School will wear a special helmet sticker this season in remembrance of Mycheal, symbolizing their support for his family, teammates, and the Kingstree community.

"Mycheal's passing is a profound loss, not only for his family and Kingstree High School, but also for the larger football family across South Carolina," said Coach Brandon Cantrell, KHS Head Coach. "Through this gesture, we want to honor his memory, stand with those grieving, and raise awareness about the impact of violence on young lives."

The sticker, featuring the initials MEW, will serve as a constant reminder of Mycheal's spirit, his contributions to the Kingstree Blazers, and the importance of unity in the face of tragedy.

Williamsburg County School District and Kingstree High School expressed gratitude to Newberry College for keeping Mycheal's memory alive and for demonstrating the deep connections that exist between schools, athletes, and communities across the state.

The Kingstree High Blazers football program will continue to honor Mycheal's memory throughout the season, while encouraging students to live with purpose, resilience, and hope.
