Advisory Board/School Council Minutes September 13, 2024

The School Council/Advisory Board met on 9-13-24 to discuss the beginning of the school year and some important events that have taken place.

Dr. Rush reported that the Step it Up fundraiser was a huge success. The school raised over \$30,000 in donations. Langston Road Primary will receive 50% of the donations, so that gives the school a little over \$15,000. Dr. Rush mentioned that some of the funds will be used to provide shade and seating on the playground for both teachers and students. This includes the cost of 2 concrete pads, 2 shade structures, tables and benches.

Dr. Rush mentioned that LRPS currently has a vacancy for a Transition Kindergarten teacher. Interviews will be held next week. The position has been posted on social media.

Fall MAP scores were shared. Dr. Rush stated that our students in first grade had very high achievement scores for both reading and math for the fall. Second grade students scored lower on achievement in both reading and math, compared to last year. Scores will be shared with grade level teams so teachers can make informed decisions regarding student improvement.

Dr. Rush shared that Dr. Frierson and Dr. Wiggins will be conducting a School Improvement visit in the very near future. She discussed the focus of high levels of student/teacher engagement in the classrooms. Dr. Rush
