1. **Call to Order:** Pam Hilliard called the Regular Meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

2. **Presentation:** Mrs. Heath, Ms. Hazeltine, and Mrs. Payne presented the new Reading Test that the State Department of Education adopted. iStations merged with Amira and is the new IRI testing mechanism. The program is AI generated and gives real time data. It's used for RTI intervention, it's a tutor system. The program helps with increased independence and confidence in the students K-3. It's game-like and has a lot of interaction.
