DUAL ENROLLMENT

Academic credit granted for course work successfully completed by a student under this program may qualify as high school credit or credit at the institution of higher education in accordance with the contract for dual credit with the eligible institution

Any student in grades 9 through 12 may apply to any accredited institution of higher education through the post-secondary enrollment program. A student may be entitled to credit toward graduation requirements for each course approved by the corporation, which the student successfully completes at that institution, in accordance with the contract for dual credit with the eligible institution the student is attending. The student's school records must indicate that the credits were earned at an eligible institution.

A student participating in this program will still be considered as enrolled in the district and eligible for all high school activities.
