

Scholarship Application Instructions

Please Note: Incomplete applications will not be accepted. Screenshots of the application are not accepted. In addition to the completed and signed application form, all students applying for a scholarship must submit the following materials:

- 1. Student Essays
- 2. Grade point average (GPA) documentation: Official transcript or report card documenting the student's cumulative GPA
- 3. Two Letters of Recommendation
- 4. Parent Information Form
- 5. Verification of household income for 2023 and 2024 (If available)
- 6. Student video, audio recording, essay, or poem (see instructions and options below)

1. STUDENT ESSAY QUESTIONS

- a. Recount a time when you experienced failure.
- b. How did it affect you and what lessons did you learn?
- c. Choose a person or persons you admire and explain why.
- d. What do you want to use your education to achieve?
- e. What are your goals after you graduate high school?
- f. How will a private, faith-based education prepare you for future endeavors?

2. GRADE POINT AVERAGE DOCUMENTATION

Submit an official transcript or school grade report showing a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher.

Official transcripts must be provided before a scholarship can be awarded. For the initial application, you may submit unofficial documents and follow up with official GPA documents later.

Official documents are in a sealed envelope from the school and are marked "Official."

3. LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

Submit two letters of recommendation. The letters cannot be from family members. We suggest asking a teacher, coach, family friend, community member, clergy, mentor, etc.

Recommendation letters must address the following questions:

- · How long have you known the student and in what capacity?
- · How will the student benefit from this opportunity?
- · What are the student's strengths?
- What skills does the student possess that will benefit him or her in private, faith-based setting?

4. PARENT INFORMATION FORM

The parent or legal guardian must complete the Parent Information Form.

5. HOUSEHOLD INCOME VERIFICATION

Submit the front page of your 1040 form for the past two years or submit copies of your W-2 forms.

6. STUDENT VIDEO, AUDIO RECORDING, ESSAY, OR POEM

Students should create a short video, record an audio statement of three minutes or less, or write an essay or poem introducing themselves to the scholarship committee and expressing what receiving the scholarship would mean to them.

Students should be as creative as possible while sharing their introduction.

If an audio file is created, share a link or attach the file with the application materials.

If an essay or poem is created, attach the file in a pdf with the application materials.

7. SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

Email application materials as attachments to theresa@texascicadas.com by November 15, 2024, at 11:59 PM (ET). We encourage students to submit their application early to avoid any delays in receiving materials due to technical difficulties. Applicants will be notified of decisions by the first week of December.
