No Tardy Picnic

One of the traditions at Starline Elementary is an event called “No Tardy Picnic”. At the end of each quarter, families enjoy a picnic-style lunch on the lower, back field with their children who have been on time for school each day.

Families bring lunch or students lunches are provided through Food Service. Blankets and folding chairs are bought by families. After the picnic lunch, families may play with their children on the playground and field. Last year we adjusted the times of the picnic so siblings could eat lunch together. The date/time for the Quarter One picnic will be **Friday, October 15 from 11:30-12:30 p.m.** This allows children time to eat as well as a little play time.

The Caravelle and Thistle Parking Lot gate will be open around 11:20 so families may arrive and get settled prior to students coming down on the field. You are welcome to park in the Visitor Parking Lot off of Thistle, so you have easier access to the field, especially if walking a far distance is a challenge for you. We will have cones labeled with grade level groups so it is easier to locate your child.

At the end of each quarter, your child starts over for the next quarter. It is a fun goal for students to strive for— being on time for school each day so they can eat lunch outside with their families.

We appreciate families that allow other children to join them on their blankets so everyone has a “family” to eat with on that special day.

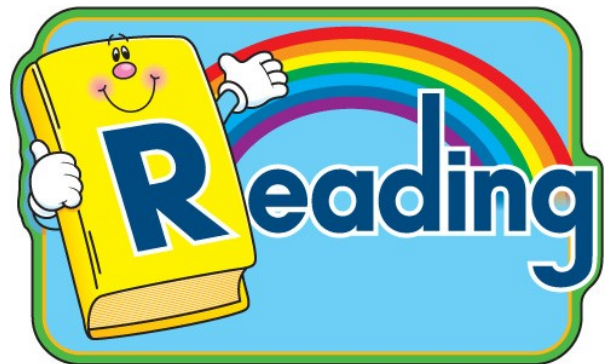
