RULES & REGULATIONS for CONTESTANT

- 1. Contestants MUST be an enrolled member of the Ramah Navajo Tribe with a census number.
- 2. Contestant must be:

16-24 years of age - Miss Ramah Navajo Queen

8-15 years of age - Miss Ramah Navajo Princess

3. Contestants must be single, never married, & with no children before and after Crowning.

(NOTE: This Pageant is very important to the Ramah Navajo/Pine Hill Community. All contestants must uphold the responsibilities of the title "Miss Ramah Navajo Queen/Princess" throughout the Pageant and throughout her reign, as well as her commitment to Ramah Navajo/Pine Hill Community.)

- **4.** Contestants should be able to speak, or be willing to learn to speak, their native language. Fluency is not required. Contestants should be able to introduce themselves in the Diné language, acknowledging their: Clans, Parents/Grandparents, School, Grade
- 5. Contestants must not be holding any other titles at the time of the Pageant. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- **6.** Contestants will answer impromptu questions asked by the judges during the modern/traditional categories.
- 7. Contestants will be judged on personality, appearance, participation, speech, essay, modern and traditional skill/talent.
- 8. Contestants must be knowledgeable of Ramah Navajo History, Navajo Culture, Values, & Traditions.
- **9.** Contestants pursuing the *Title* of "*Miss Ramah Navajo Queen*" must not be registered for active duty with any military service.
- 10. All Contestants must understand that if she engages in any activities, during or after the Pageant, which is characterized as dishonest, immoral, immodest, indecent, the Pageant Coordinators will address the misconduct immediately with the Contestant, which may result in disqualification to compete in the Pageant or hold the *Title* of "Miss Ramah Navajo Queen/Princess". If for any reason she (Miss Ramah Navajo Queen/Princess) shall violate or does not abide by the listed rules and regulations, she shall relinquish her title to the first-runner up recipient.
- 11. All Contestants need to understand the primary function of the "Miss Ramah Navajo Queen/Princess" is to serve as a Goodwill Ambassador for our Elders, Youth and Community Members, and serve as an official representative of the Ramah/Pine Hill Navajo Community. She is the ambassador for the surrounding communities, and the State of New Mexico, Arizona, and throughout the Navajo Nation.

- **12.** All Contestants must understand the *Title* of "Miss Ramah Navajo Queen/Princess" is one of the most prestigious titles that represent the Ramah Navajo people. "Miss Ramah Navajo Queen/Princess" will need to represent and promote the Tradition, Custom and Values of the Navajo People. The "Title" must be respected, and treated with honor, dignity, and integrity because it signifies the beauty of our people, language, tradition, culture, and our ways of life. It is not to be disrespected and treated unfairly in any way during the Pageant and throughout the reign.
- 13. Contestants will be assigned a number for judging purposes and must wear their number through-out the pageant.
- **14.** All Contestants *MUST PARTICIPATE* in the following events for points (5 pts for participation, and 0 pts for no show):
- *Events to attend will be discussed at the welcoming meeting, TBA
- *Please attach a copy of your "platform essay" when returning the application.
- *Contestants for the Miss Ramah Navajo Queen/Princess Pageant are responsible for all entry fees.
- 15. "Miss Ramah Navajo Queen/Princess" Contestant Application deadline is Monday, August 18, 2025, by 5:00 p.m.
