Cook County Schools COVID-19 Guidelines

2021-2022

⇒If You Test Positive for COVID-19, Isolate.

Everyone, regardless of vaccination status:

- Stay home for 5 days.
- If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolved after 5 days, you may return to work or school on day 6.
- Wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.

If you have a fever, stay home until your fever resolves.

⇒If You Were Exposed to Someone with COVID-19:

If you:

Have been boosted,

OR

Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months,

OR

Completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months,

- Wear a mask around others for 10 days.
- Test on day 5, if possible.
- If someone in your home tests positive for COVID-19, you may continue to come to work or school.

If you develop symptoms, get tested. If positive for COVID-19, follow the "Test Positive" protocol above.

If you:

Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over 6 months ago and are not boosted,

OR

Completed the primary series of J&J over 2 months ago and are not boosted,

OR

Are unvaccinated,

- You must wear a mask around others for 10 days.
- Test on day 5, if possible.
- If someone in your home tests positive for COVID-19:
 - You must stay home for 5 days.
 - On day 6, return to work or school and wear a mask for 5 additional days.

If you develop symptoms, get tested. If positive for COVID-19, follow the "Test Positive" protocol above.
