1. Applicant and Co-Applicant (if applicable):

2. Student Information - names, birth dates, social security #s

3. Income Information - be prepared to answer information about how you file federal taxes, etc. This will ask if you own a business, farm, etc. You will also likely need to provide additional documentation with your income tax forms, if you do.

4. Non taxable income - Choose ways that you might receive nontaxable income, such as child support, VA Benefits, etc. Pop-up boxes will appear asking you to input the amount you receive and whether it is monthly, weekly, etc.
