SECTION I: GRADE LEVEL REQUIRED COURSES

ENGLISH-Please select either English II or English II Honors. A teacher recommendation is required for the honors level course. There will be a summer assignment for this course .

WORLD HISTORY-All sophomores are required to take a World History course.

AP WORLD HISTORY-Received a B or above in English I and teacher recommendation. There will be a summer assignment for this course.

SECTION II: MATH COURSE

INTERNATIONAL MATH II (H) Any student who received a C or better in the second semester of Math I Honors. Teacher recommendation signature required.

INTERNATIONAL MATH II-Any student that has a C or better in 2nd semester of International Math I.

INTERNATIONAL MATH B-Any student who passed at least one semester of Math A with a passing grade.

SECTION III: SCIENCE

Please place a mark next to your science choice. If balloting for two science courses, mark an X next to each course.

SECTION IV: ELECTIVES

Please select your top four selections with number one being the top request. If you are requesting a class that requires an approval signature, seek the appropriate instructor.
