The school schedule is 7:55 am-3:45 pm!

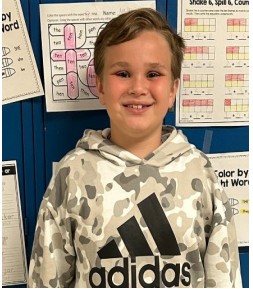
Attendance at school is very important.

Devon is a great friend to his classmates and is always willing to give a helping hand.

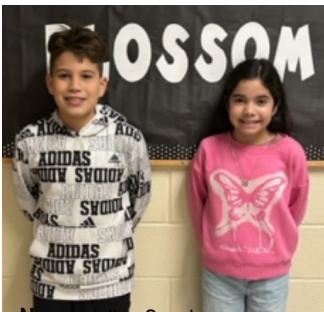
Future Dream: Devon wants to be a professional Football player when he grows up.
