SC #100 BOE Adopted July 19, 2021: Reviewed December 20, 2021, Revised/Reviewed  
March 21, 2022 and August 15, 2022**

Here at Stark County CUSD #100, we are proud to have successfully navigated the 2020, 2021 and 2022 COVID19 Pandemic with full in person learning. Below are updated guidelines for the 2022-23 school year as it may pertain to additional pandemic protocols.

- School Schedule: 8:00 – 3:00 daily; Early Release August 17th – September 2st: 8:00 am – 1:45pm; Early Release Wednesdays beginning after Labor Day 8:00 am – 1:45 pm, weekly. Last day of school, May 26, 2022 (11:00 am dismissal for students).

**UPDATE 18 July 2022**

**The Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) and Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) have updated this joint summary, fully adopting the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Operational Guidance for K-12 Schools and Early Care and Education Programs to Support Safe In-Person Learning and related CDC FAQ (updated as of July 27, 2022). This updated guidance supersedes all prior COVID-19 school guidance documents and applies to all public and nonpublic schools that serve students in pre-kindergarten through grade 12 (pre-K-12). Guidance is found at link below. Stark County will begin the 2022-23 school year with the minimal guidelines as it completed the spring, 2022 semester as it relates to COVID19. Stark County #100 will use the latest guidance available for the 2022-23 school year and adjust accordingly as guidelines change.**

**All mitigations subject to change based on local health metrics, IDPH and CDC Guidelines and/or executive orders throughout the year.**

- The district will be prepared to adjust educational and athletic programming as necessary throughout the year per IHSA/IESA and IDPH guidance. Students who are vaccinated may have less interruptions of schooling and extra curricula's based on the current IDPH guidelines.
- Buildings will continue to undergo extensive cleaning/sanitation. Good hand hygiene will be strongly encouraged at all grade levels. New HVAC systems have been installed to improve air quality at both campuses.
- Student meals will be free for the 2022-2023 school year in accordance with USDA reimbursements and district grants. Lunch rooms and locker rooms will be fully operational. Field trips and fundraisers will resume as normal.
- Athletic programs will run as normal with full activity fees charged and gate admissions at home events per IHSA/IESA guidelines and schedules per sport. Athletics will follow quarantine procedures per guidance of IHSA/IESA.
