JOB DESCRIPTION: (Synopsis, full position description upon request) This position is a Full time/Unclassified Cook Senior at the Kansas State School for the Deaf. This position will assist with the serving of food to students in the Kansas School for the Deaf. Assist in KSD Dietary Services. Prepares, cooks, and bakes items on a planned menu according to multi-step recipes or 200+ students. Prepares special dietary foods. Assures the meals are prepared and ready for each scheduled meal. In absence of a Food Service Supervisor, individuals are responsible for start-up of meals and the securing of the food service line in the evening and making sure other workers complete tasks assigned. Operates institutional cooking equipment, not limited to: ovens, toasters, mixers, steam cookers, food choppers with safety procedures. Cleans and/or supervises the cleaning of all equipment. Serves as lead worker for part-time students and food service workers. Rotates inventories on a scheduled basis. Transports bulk items to work areas for preparation. Assists in receiving delivered food products. Rotates inventories on a scheduled basis. Transports bulk items to work areas for preparation. Other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: High School diploma or GED, one-year experience in institutional cooking/baking preferred. Training in safety and sanitation and in operation of dishwashing equipment. Training in cooking baked food products is preferred. Ability to write legibly, read and understand written and oral directives. Ability to work effectively with fellow workers and others. Ability or willingness to learn ASL with hearing impaired. Considerable knowledge of quantity food preparation; health and safety standards, equipment operation and general handling and receiving of food storage items. Ability to lift and carry heavy objects. Ability to learn the use and care of equipment, materials, utensils, and methods used in food service. Ability to understand and follow written and oral instructions. Ability to work long hours in rooms at high temperatures. Ability to work in a cold storage room when necessary. Kitchen/Cafeteria and Educational/classroom environment. ASL and English skills will be assessed.
