Nonpublic School Services Elementary School Counseling Notification

Colonial Intermediate Unit 20 provides school counseling services to St. Anne's through its Act 89 Auxiliary Services program. These services consist primarily of *small group, classroom, and/or school-wide school-based counseling lessons, conducting student risk and/or threat assessments, crisis response, consultation, and test interpretation*. In certain situations, the school counselor may do periodic *check-ins* with students on their caseload.

Description of Services

Small Group Lessons- These are lessons that will be taught in a small group to work on a variety of social, emotional, behavioral, or academic skills with the students' peers. Parent(s)/Guardian(s) will be contacted to sign a permission form in order to participate.

Classroom Lessons- These are lessons that will be taught to the whole class to enrich a variety of social, emotional, behavioral, or academic skills. Parent(s)/Guardian(s) will receive a flyer from the classroom teacher indicating the lesson topic and anticipated date of the lesson.

School-Wide Lessons- These are lessons or activities that will be done school-wide to promote a safe and healthy environment. The principal is always aware of these activities and gives his/her approval before they begin.

Risk Assessments- If a parent, teacher, peer, or principal becomes aware that a student expresses intent to harm *themselves*, the school counselor will attempt to contact parent(s)/guardian(s) for consent to assess. If the parent(s)/guardian(s) cannot be reached, the school counselor will assess if the student is at risk of harming *themselves*. After the assessment, the school counselor will contact the parent(s)/guardian(s) to discuss the outcome of the assessment, the next steps, and to develop a safety plan if needed.

Threat Assessments- If a parent, teacher, peer, or principal becomes aware that a student expresses intent to harm *someone else*, the school counselor will attempt to contact parent(s)/guardian(s) for consent to assess. If the parent(s)/guardian(s) cannot be reached, the counselor will assess if the student is at risk of harming *someone else*. After the assessment, the school counselor will contact the parent(s)/guardian(s) to discuss the outcome of the assessment, the next steps, and to develop a safety plan if needed.

Crisis Response- The school counselor may provide individual, group, or school-wide support when a crisis or potentially traumatic event occurs involving someone within the school community.

Consultation- The school counselor may need to consult with parents, teachers, or the principal regarding a student's academic, social, behavioral, or emotional needs. To provide appropriate recommendations and/or interventions, an observation of the student in their school setting may be conducted when collecting information for a consultation.

Periodic Check-Ins- The school counselor may briefly check-in with a student experiencing temporary trauma like death in the family, moving, changes to family dynamic, or suddenly getting upset at school, etc.- this is NOT to provide an ongoing individual counseling service.

Test Interpretation- The school counselor, typically at the request of the principal, teacher, or parent(s)/guardian(s), looks for a pattern within various test results to gain further academic insight in regards to a specific situation.

PARENT INFORMATION REMINDER

ALL absences MUST be reported by 8:45 AM. For your convenience, the telephone messaging service answers 24-7. You may call anytime to report your absence if it is by 8:45 AM. If the absence is not reported by that time, it is marked as "Negligence of Parent" on Option C

If you have any change of dismissal, such as car rider, bus rider, walker, Extended Care, please call the Main Office by 2:30 PM at 610-868-4182. It is best to call the Main Office instead of contacting the teacher by email. Teachers, at times, do not have the luxury of checking their messages because of teaching. Therefore, the dismissal change would not occur.

Doctor appointments, early dismissals, etc. should have a note sent in the day before to alert the teacher so it could be entered on the daily roster for all teachers affected to know and it also avoids a disturbance in the teaching process. When returning to school, the student should have a note from the doctor stating that the student was there for an appointment.

Please fill out the parent paperwork that was sent home last week in the Communication Parent Packet if you have not done so yet. This is vital information that is needed for certain funding for the school.
