School dances are held to allow students a venue for fun and enjoying one another's company. Please remember that JPII has an obligation to ensure that behavior at dances is appropriate.

JPII dance attire must adhere to the following guidelines:

Students are expected to be clean and neat in their personal appearance, observing standards of modesty and Christian morality. Parents of a student whose attire does not meet these guidelines as determined by the chaperones will be contacted to bring an appropriate outfit that meets the requirements.

We want to make this a joyful and memorable event for all students, therefore, we strongly encourage students to bring a picture of themselves in their semi-formal wear for approval prior to the dance.

- · Dress in semi-formal wear that also is appropriate attire and remains on during the duration of the dance
- $\cdot\,$ Dress length should be at fingertip length
- · No miniskirts
- $\cdot\,$ No 2-piece dresses with midriff exposed
- · No cut outs exposing skin
- · No see-through, spandex, skin-tight apparel
- · No lingerie-type apparel
- \cdot No dresses with an excessive slit or excessive slits, slits should not be above fingertip length
- $\cdot\,$ No bare midriff or crop tops shirts
- · No plunging necklines, please keep a modest neckline
- · No shorts allowed
- · All dress shirts must have a collar

Dance Code of Conduct:

- Students must arrive by 8PM, at the latest. Parents will be contacted if the student has not arrived.
- No student is to come to a social activity any later than one hour after the activity begins.
- Once a student and/or date leaves the dance, he/she will not be readmitted.
- No tickets will be sold at the door.
- Upon arrival, students and dates must sign their names and time.
- Absolutely no outside containers.
- Purses, bags and jackets will be locked in a secure area. A chaperone will accompany any student who needs to retrieve an item from the secure area.
- AS A COURTESY TO THE CHAPERONES, PARENTS AND GUARDIANS, PLEASE ARRANGE TO HAVE TRANSPORTATION FOR YOUR CHILD PROMPTLY AT THE END OF THE DANCE 10:00 PM
- Students who have been requested to leave JPII for disciplinary reasons are not allowed to attend as guests.
- Students are expected to be orderly and courteous toward all supervisory personnel, students, faculty, and parents.
- Dancing: Suggestive, sensual, or inappropriate dancing is not permitted. Students must demonstrate respect for each other in their physical contact and their language. Inappropriate behavior on the dance floor will not be tolerated.
- Grinding, front to back dancing, students dancing suggestively together or any sexually suggestive dance gestures or movements are not allowed. Moshing and slamming are not allowed.
- Students choosing to engage in inappropriate dance behavior will be removed from the dance floor and may not be allowed to attend the next school dance. Other disciplinary action may be taken as deemed necessary by the administration.
- Any student found under the influence or in possession of drugs, tobacco, or alcohol will be detained and released only to a parent or guardian. A date and time will be set with the student and parent or guardian to determine appropriate consequences.
