## Uniform Policy

### 2024-2025

The purpose of this uniform policy is to meet the requirements set forth by the Mobile County Public School System. Uniform dress code will be monitored on campus throughout the school day. Uniforms are used as a tool to ensure student safety through visual identification. All students are expected to observe basic standards of cleanliness, modesty, pride, good judgement, and good grooming. Clothing should fit and be worn appropriately.

### HMS Uniform Policy

<p><b>Shirts</b></p>	<p><b>6<sup>th</sup> Grade:</b> Solid <b>ROYAL BLUE</b> polo style shirt  <b>7<sup>th</sup> Grade:</b> Solid <b>GRAY</b> polo style shirt  <b>8<sup>th</sup> Grade:</b> Solid <b>BLACK</b> polo style shirt</p> <p>*Shirt may be short or long sleeve with two-four buttons with a collar.          *Shirt tails <b>MUST</b> be tucked in 360 degrees.          *Long sleeve undershirts may be worn during inclement weather and <b>MUST be SOLID WHITE, BLACK, ROYAL, or GRAY.</b></p> <p>***Hankins Grade Level T-Shirts (in the appropriate grade level color) may be worn Monday – Friday. Shirts must be purchased from the school. Spirit shirts (clubs/athletics/organizations) may only be worn on Fridays. <b>NON-HMS t-shirts are not permitted!</b></p>
<p><b>Pants</b></p>	<p>Pants must be khaki uniform style pants with belt loops.</p> <p>*Pants <b>MUST</b> be worn at the natural waist and end above the shoe – <b>NO</b> sagging, hipster, joggers, cargo styles, or tight pants permitted. <b>NO</b> shorts allowed.</p>
<p><b>Belts</b></p>	<p>Belts <b>MUST</b> be worn – no studs, embellishments, or large buckles permitted.</p>
<p><b>Shoes/Socks</b></p>	<p>Shoes <b>MUST</b> be athletic style shoes with socks. <b>NO</b> crocs, slides, slippers, etc.</p>
<p><b>Outerwear</b></p>	<p>Outerwear <b>MUST</b> be solid <b>BLACK, ROYAL BLUE, OR GRAY. NO</b> logos (only school approved logos permitted).  <b>***NO HOODIES ALLOWED ON CAMPUS***</b></p> <p>*On inclement weather days, winter coats will be permitted but <b>MUST</b> be removed before entering the school building. Winter coats <b>CANNOT</b> have a hood.</p>
<p><b>Bookbags</b></p>	<p><b>ONLY CLEAR or MESH</b> bookbags permitted.</p>
<p><b>Headwear</b></p>	<p><b>NO</b> hats, toboggans, or head coverings of any kind are permitted on campus or bus.  <b>NO</b> bandannas are permitted on campus.</p>
<p><b>Jewelry</b></p>	<p><b>NO</b> visible body piercings other than ear lobes are permitted.</p>
<p><b>Other</b></p>	<p>Students are <b>REQUIRED</b> to wear their student badges at all times.          Hair <b>MUST</b> be natural in color.          Students <b>MUST</b> abide by the digital device policy.</p>

By signing, I understand that any student not in compliance of the school uniform policy cannot participate in the regular school day. Students will be given a warning letter, placed in retrack, and/or suspended. Parents of students who may have medical or religious reasons for not strictly abiding by the uniform policy should schedule a conference with the principal.
