DAILY TRANSPORTATION!

Students at Moline have ONE primary mode of transportation, this is how they will get home on a regular school day. If a student's method of transportation needs changed (permanently or on a given day due to a specific circumstance), parents/guardians must contact the front office (leave a voice message if no one answers!) before 2:30 PM. Please do not contact the child's individual classroom teacher, as records must be kept in the office related to transportation changes daily. Changes will not be made by verbal communication from children.

- No students may be signed out or changes made to students' transportation after 2:30 PM (call the school before 2:30 PM).
- Dismissal begins at 3:00 PM and all students should be picked up by 3:15 PM.
 - Parents picking up in cars should remain in their vehicles and stay in the car line, no exceptions. <u>Car rider signs should be</u> visible in the front passenger window visor.
 - Parents walking to pick up students should wait at the entrance/exit to the parking lot at the walker pick-up points
 - Changes at daycares should be communicated to us by families. For example, if a daycare is closed on a given day, please call the school to let us know.

If you'd like to sit down in person, please reach out to set an appointment. It is important to me to focus on you and your student, so appointments are needed for all parent meetings.

SEPTEMBER

All students at Moline receive free lunch. They may take a school lunch, even if they bring a home lunch. Students may also bring a water bottle and/or a small snack (single serving only).

Not allowed at lunch are: soda or sugary drinks, candy, or large bags of chips. Students may not share home food with any other students. No open food may leave the cafeteria, unless it is sealed in a lunch box.

Please encourage your child to EAT at lunch! Students have 30 minutes for lunch, and they must clean up at the end of their lunch shift, even if they haven't finished their food.

We understand students may need a cell phone for safety reasons before/after school. At Moline, the expectations for students' cell phones are simple!

**Powered off AND **In your backpack

Students cell phones will be taken by Moline staff if they are out of their backpacks during the school day, make noise of any kind, or cause any other disruption to the learning environment. School administration will return the phone at his/her discretion (may be returned to the child <u>or</u> parent may be required to pick up).

Please do not attempt to contact your child on his/her phone during the day. To get a message to your child, call the school office. No changes to students' transportation will be made over the phone on a students' personal cell phone, including via text messages.

Riverview Gardens elementary schools are UNIFORM schools. Students are expected to be in uniform daily. We follow and enforce this district-approved uniform policy:

- Any solid colored polo-style (or collared) shirt
- Khaki, navy, or black uniform bottoms (shorts, pants, skorts, jumpers)
- Rubber-soled shoes with a back

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The temperature varies inside the school building. Students may bring a jacket or sweatshirt to wear over the uniform. Hoods should remain down inside the building.

NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH UNIFORM POLICY: Jeans, Crocs, leggings (without a skirt or jumper), t-shirts. sweatpants. sandals of any kind.

Moline staff may give students a uniform to change into if they come to school out of uniform. We may contact a parent to bring the student a uniform.

Moline Elementary partners with SoulFisher Ministries to provide aftercare for our students that includes transportation home in the evening. Space is limited and enrollment (and acceptance into the program) is required. Student participation in Aftercare requires:

- Students stay for the entirety of the program from 3:00-6:00 PM (students should not be picked up early)
- Appropriate student behavior during the program (the same expectations as during the school day)
- Regular attendance (5 days per week)

If you are interested in enrolling in SoulFisher Aftercare, please call the school office and request an enrollment application. Programming begins on Monday, Sept 16. Applications are due Monday, Sept 9 to be considered and accepted.


