Four Year Old Cancer Patient Recognized at Football Game Local Businesses Collected Money for Cancer Treatment



HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – Keason Milton, a four-year-old cancer patient, was recognized during the Northside High School and Houston County High School football game on October 29. Keason was diagnosed two years ago with a rare type of tissue cancer. He was also selected as the Children’s Miracle Network Ambassador for the Beverly Knight Olson Children’s Hospital. Keason’s brother, Keron Milton, is a sophomore wide receiver for the Northside Eagles.

State Farm agent Andy Thomas and the Graphic Guys purchased t-shirts for 150 students at each school to show their support for Keason. Cheerleaders and band members from Northside High and Houston County High wore a yellow ribbon, and football players on both teams wore a decal on their football helmets featuring Keason’s initials.

Prior to the game, Keason and his family joined principals and coaches on the field for a special presentation. Over \$3,600 was collected at the game to help offset Keason’s medical expenses, which cost around \$5,000 per month. A group of local businesses plan to match the donations that were received.
