A few of my favorites:

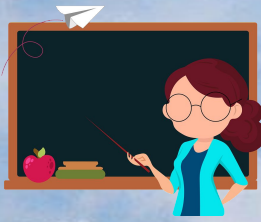
Colors: Red, purple, and blue

Food: Pizza and mashed potatoes and gravy

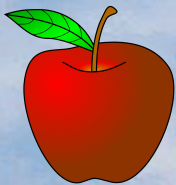




# Educational Philosophy

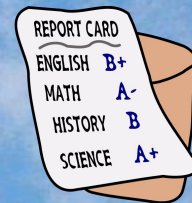

# Report Card Policies

## Grading Scale



90-100=4 (Exceeding standard - Consistently grasps, applies, and extends the grade level standard)
