STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

- KSA data has been released. Our overall index is 66.2 which was an increase from the previous year.
- Millbrooke currently has the highest student attendance each month. Our kids want to be here.
- We are currently making strategic changes to increase scores in 4th grade Math and Science.
- Staff have been diving in to our current MAP data. Our current index in Reading for students in K-5 is 61.46. Our current index in Math for students in K-5 is 65.65. Our current index in Math for students in grades 3-5 is 62.4 and our current index in Reading for students in grades 3-5 is 62.1. Reading index in grades K-2 is 62.0 and Math is 69.4.
