Dear Silver Streak Families,

Thank you for such a strong start to the school year! We appreciate the efforts being made to have your child at school each day and on time. Our Silver Streaks had an average rate of 92%. This is an increase from last August. Way to Go! We are grateful for the Lake Wales Charter Schools Foundation for the support of the Read 20 initiative. Janie Howard Wilson kicked off our Read 20 event with a magician doing a magic show to connect how reading can create magical moments! The students also heard about the first AR celebration and they are ready to get started with collecting their points. Please make sure to encourage this excitement by reading with your child every night for twenty minutes.

The IB PYP Curriculum is organized into six units of study based on six transdisciplinary themes. Grades K-5 study all six themes throughout the school year organized into units. The units last between four and eight weeks. The six themes provide students with the opportunity to incorporate local and global issues into their learning. Through incorporating local and global issues into the curriculum, students can go beyond the confines of learning within each subject area.

The six themes are: How the World Works. How We Organize Ourselves; Where We Are in Place and Time; Sharing the Planet; How We Express Ourselves; and Who We Are. Teachers design lines of inquiry to guide the unit. Skills, known as approaches to learning are incorporated to ensure students are learning valuable skills that transcend the subjects. These skills include: Research skills, communication skills, social skills, self-management skills and thinking skills. Units are designed to promote critical thinking as well as help students to become well rounded in other areas of their life.

Teachers organize units to meet the local and state requirements. Teachers also ensure foundational skills are met through the University of Florida (UFLI) program. When students work their units, they learn about other countries, cultures, ways to take action and ways we can share the planet with other people and other living things. They learn ways to express themselves, learn about who they are as individuals and as a community. They also learn how our world works and how the world is organized.

This month, your child will complete their progress monitoring assessments. This information will let the teacher know your child's strengths. The first interim reports will be going home the week of September 11th. We look forward to seeing all our families at our upcoming Open House on September 7th at 6:00pm. Hello parents! Kindergarten is finishing Beginning of Year testing and we will be sending that information home soon. As we get ready to send homework, please practice handwriting with your child as we are also working on it at school. Our goal is to have your child writing independently within the next month. Please practice tying shoes at home and how to take their belt on/off.

We're looking forward to seeing their growth within the next couple of months!

First Grade

First Grade has hit the ground running!! The students are so excited to be in different classrooms with new teachers; the teacher team is even more excited than the students. The students are proudly displaying the skills they learned in Kindergarten. It is a huge jump from Kindergarten to 1 st Grade, so with patience and perseverance, these students are settling in to rigorous, stimulating activities. We are on target with all of our curriculum maps while spiraling our lessons to make sure the Kindergarten skills are intact. The students are using new IB PYP vocabulary in oral discussions as well as using manipulatives in ELA, Math, and Science to enhance the learning experience. We are really happy with the communication efforts in Class DoJo, however, there are still a few stakeholders that have not joined our efforts. Please take the time to join the Class DoJo, that is our most effective medium for communication. Remember to check the agenda and initial it daily.

Second Grade

Students have become familiarized with their routines and procedures within the classroom. We have jumped into the curriculum head first. Our transdisciplinary theme for the next six weeks will be "Who We Are". In reading, students will be learning about main story elements and how to determine the plot and theme of a text. In math, we will be learning how to add and subtract with facts up to 20. There will be engaging activities to help students master place values of numbers up to 1,000 as well. We will be exploring the human body in science. We are learning about the major organs in the body and how they function. As we set the atmosphere for treating each other fairly and being respectful, the students will learn about different cultures and how families around the world are the same and different. Parents, we encourage you to stay connected through Classdojo and reach out if they have any questions or concerns.

Third Grade

During the month of September third grade will continue focusing on how the world works for our transdisciplinary theme. We will still be focusing on the interaction between the natural world (physical and biological) and human societies across all subjects. The students will be learning about how different cultures and landmarks can help them understand different cultural backgrounds, identifying and classifying the different states of matter, identifying contributions from various ethnic groups around the world to the United States and understanding place value with addition and subtraction for multi digit numbers in relation to multiplication. The students will continue to work on the key concepts of connection and perspective through social and communication skills during the month of September.

<u>Fourth Grade</u>

4th Grade Teachers are loving having your children, and we have had fun getting to know them.

We will be wrapping up Beginning of the Year testing and will compile all the data to best service your child.

Forthcoming is a 'Welcome to 4th Grade' phone call. Your child's teacher should have reached out to build a positive rapport along with providing a contact number should you have any questions and concerns.

We are in the process of scheduling field trips in the upcoming months. Please help us monitor behavior in the classroom as well as instilling citizenship and acceptance of others. Lastly, we will be taking on our spelling tests every Friday morning and also homework is due every Friday morning. We are finishing Unit 1 on place value and numbers to one million. We appreciate your support. Your children are amazing! Learning ROCKS!

Fifth Grade

We focused on procedures and expectations throughout the month of August. This will continue the rest of the year! Our 5 th graders are really impressing us with how they are following directions, exceeding expectations, and being leaders of the school! For the month of September in Math, students will be learning about place value and multi-digit numbers and decimals to the thousandths place. We will be continuously practicing our math facts and encourage students and their families to practice them at home. In ELA, we will be working on understanding historical fiction and using text evidence to respond to reading. Students should be reading at least 20 minutes a day and recording a summary in their reading logs. We will be focusing on argumentative writing. In Science, we will be learning about sharing the planet (adaptation of organisms, flow of energy in a food chain, organs of the human body, classification of plants and animals, and life cycles of plants and animals). In Social Studies, we will be learning about geography, geographic tools, Florida's history and regions including information about Native Americans and early explorers.

Please support and encourage your students to complete their homework each night. Mrs. Sotomayor (math) has a math folder where homework is to be completed. Mrs. Maldonado (ELA) and Dr. Klepacki (science/social studies) share ONE homework journal. ELA and Science/Social Studies is to be completed in the student's homework journal. Homework is to be completed each night! Teachers check for homework every day!
