

Teach Residency Alternative Certification Track

(DESE MO Certification)

Earn your certificate while teaching.

The Teach Residency Alternative Certification program is designed for people who want to teach and become a certified teacher at the same time. Teacher candidates must have earned a baccalaureate degree from an accredited college or university with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher. In addition, candidates must secure and maintain a full-time teaching position for two years in any accredited public, private or charter school in the St. Louis region. UMSL will provide the necessary coursework to earn teacher certification within the two years.

This online cohort-based program is offered in 2-year cycles, so it's essential that participants commit to the time line and requirements of this program.
