May 12, 2022

Present: Jodi Short, Tara Hill, April Strevig, Tiffany Branson, Chris Bentley, Lorinda Hultquist, Sonya Kiefer, and Bobby Jones

April Strevig started the meeting with the pledge. She then opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.

The agenda for the meeting was reviewed. Chris Bentley then made a motion to approve the agenda. Jodi Short seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous and the motion carried.

The minutes of the April meetings were reviewed as well as the minutes from the teacher election in May. Tara Hill then made a motion to approve the agenda. Tiffany Branson seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous and the motion carried.

Dr. Strevig announced the results of the parent and teacher elections. Lorinda Hultquist was elected as the parent representative – 1 year. Bobby Jones was re-elected as the parent representative – 2 year. Chris Bentley was re-elected as the parent/business 1 year, and Tiffany Branson was re-elected as the parent/business 2 year. Tara Hill was re-elected as the teacher representative 1 year, and Jodi Short was re-elected as the teacher representative 2 year.

Dr. Sonya Kiefer gave an update on our School Improvement Plan and Instructional Updates. All students in K – 2 are taking the MAP Reading Fluency test. This is not required at all levels, but as a school, we have decided to do this because of the reading data we receive on all students. Teachers can also pull up the recording of the reading and share this with parents and students to discuss fluency, decoding, and comprehension. This is the third time we have taken this assessment this year. The data coming in looks great.

Dr. Strevig shared that our students are also completing the gifted screener. This will identify any possible gifted students that we have not identified already this school year.

We will use all of the data collected over the year to form classes for next year.

Our GOAL books will be updated and sent to all teachers prior to the start of next school year.

April discussed the upcoming professional learning opportunities for our faculty and staff. Members of the leadership team will be a part of the district leadership collaboration on June 1. Several teacher leaders were selected to be a part of a Solution Tree workshop in

Orlando – Professional Learning Communities at Work. Grade level teachers are attending a summer Fountas & Pinnell reading institute.

We are having end of the year celebrations for the first time since 2019. PK and 2nd will have their celebrations in the building and tickets will be distributed and limited due to seating and space. K and 1st will have some celebrations, but they will be outside.

The council voted for chairpersons and a secretary. Jodi Short nominated Chris Bentley as the chair. Tara Hill seconded the nomination. He accepted the position and was elected chair unanimously. Tiffany Branson nominated Bobby Jones as the vice-chair. Chris Bentley seconded the nomination. Bobby accepted the position and was elected vice-chair unanimously. Bobby Jones nominated Jodi Short as the secretary. Chris Bentley seconded the nomination. Jodi accepted the position and was elected secretary unanimously.
