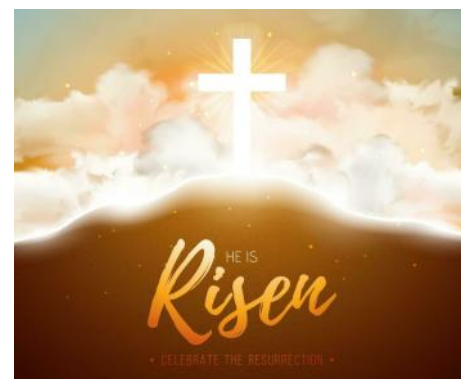
Use Your Tax Dollars to Support Lutheran Education

From the Desk of Mrs. Kiehne:

What is A+?

A+ is a program to help Missouri students pay for two years of post-high school education at two-year public colleges in Missouri. Some vocational/technical schools in Missouri also accept A+. Everyone at Saxony (who is a Missouri resident) can be part of A+. Please see the [A+ website](https://dhewd.mo.gov/ppc/grants/aplusscholarship.php) at <https://dhewd.mo.gov/ppc/grants/aplusscholarship.php> for more information. The requirements to earn an A+ Scholarship are as follows:

Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.

Enter into a **written agreement** with your high school prior to graduation (*most of you did this at your Crusader Curriculum Orientation as a Freshman*).

Attend a designated A+ high school for 2 years immediately prior to graduation (*that's Saxony!*).

Graduate with an **overall grade point average of 2.5** or higher on a 4.0 scale.

Have at least a **95% attendance record overall for grades 9-12** (*parent request absences count against this!*).

Perform at least **50 hours of unpaid tutoring or mentoring**, of which up to 25% (12.5 hours of the 50) may include job shadowing prior to graduation.

Maintain a record of **good citizenship and avoid the unlawful use of drugs and/or alcohol** while in grades 9-12.

Earn a **qualifying score on the mathematics section** of the ACT.

If hours accrued for Saxony Service hours involve tutoring or mentoring, they can do double duty as A+ hours. The 50 A+ hours can also include 12.5 hours of job shadowing. Students are able to tutor another student at Saxony with my assistance (I would set you up with a student), or students can tutor at another school, as long as a teacher signs off on the log form. Students cannot be paid for the hours they use for A+. Since 50 hours are required, it is a good idea to begin accruing hours beginning in 9th grade. **For graduating seniors, A+ hours are due to Mrs. Kiehne by May 1st!!** If you earn A+, a special seal is placed on your final transcript and you can request that it be sent to the A+ affiliated school. You will need to meet with the financial aid department to finalize all of the details and costs.

Some four-year universities in Missouri are starting to give A+ recognition scholarships to those who earn it. These may be only \$1000, but that is still helpful! Listing A+ recognition on a high school activities resume is a good thing to do to make you stand out from others since there are a lot of requirements to meet to earn it.

Summer School Information






Physical Education class will again be offered on campus at Saxony Lutheran High School this summer from **May 20th to June 10th** (no classes on Memorial Day). The class meets in person at Saxony from 8:00 am—12:00 pm, Monday - Thursday with Friday Learn-From-Home days. Students must be participating in class activities as directed by the instructors, but do not need to come to Saxony Lutheran High School on Fridays. Students may not miss more than **FOUR** hours total during the summer school session, including absences and tardies, in order to receive the half credit of PE for the course. No refunds will be given. Transportation is not provided, but students have carpooled to and from class in the past.

Saxony dress code applies. Students may wear Saxony uniform shirts, Saxony spirit wear, or school-appropriate T-shirts. The required length for shorts will follow the "dollar bill test." Athletic shoes are preferred. All Saxony handbook rules apply. Students who violate rules or disrupt class will be dismissed from the course with no refund.

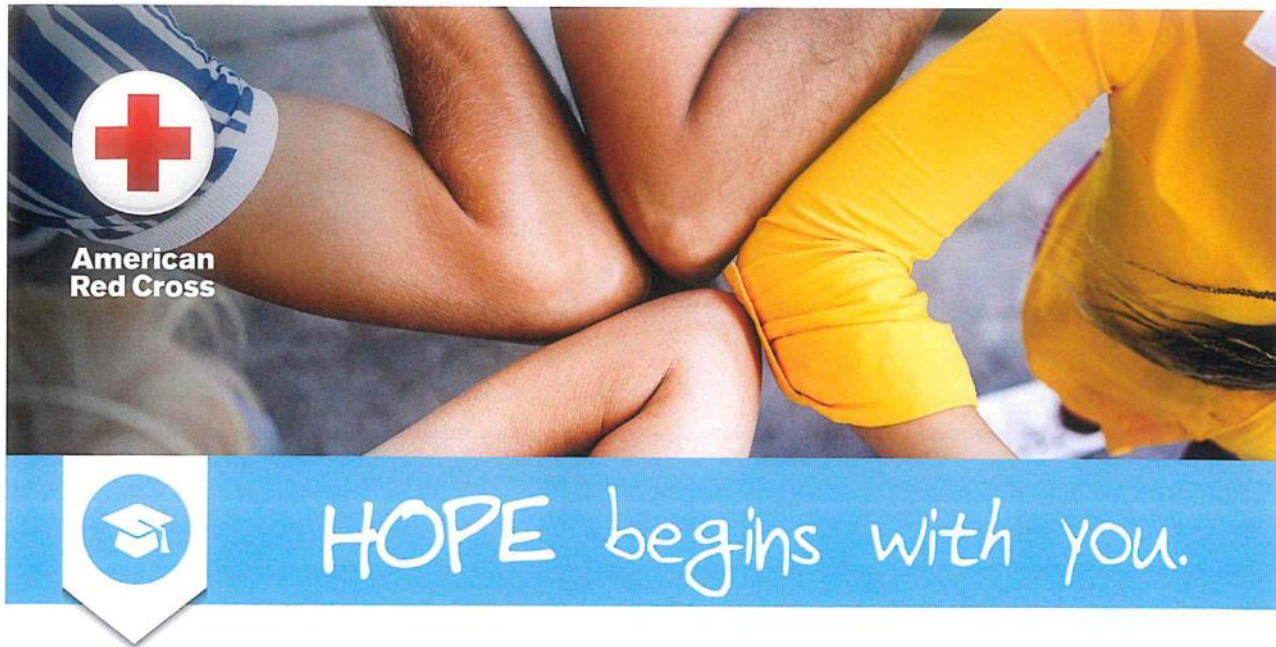
Parents or guardians may complete the Microsoft Form ([Summer PE 2026 Registration – Fill out form](#)) to register each student who will be taking the summer Physical Education course at Saxony. (One entry for each student.) Current Saxony 9th - 11th grade students will be given priority for placement in the class, then siblings of current students. Full tuition payment of \$250 is required to secure a spot in the course. Cash, check, or credit cards are accepted in the office.

Other Summer School classes are available in June (1st – 26th) and July (6th - 31st) through Launch. Please complete the Microsoft Form here: [Summer School Plans \(Summer PE at Saxony & other options\) – Fill out form](#) with the class you would like to take and whether you need the June or July session. I handle all of the registration tasks and it is free. These might be a good choice if your goal is to take Band, Choir, Art, or Ag classes for all four years at Saxony.

If you do not have an account already, you will need to set up a login and then choose your classes. I approve your registration. You must pay SEMO tuition of \$95 per credit hour. 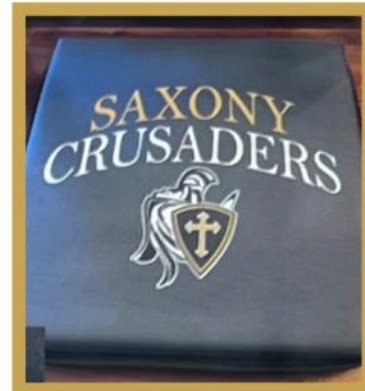
