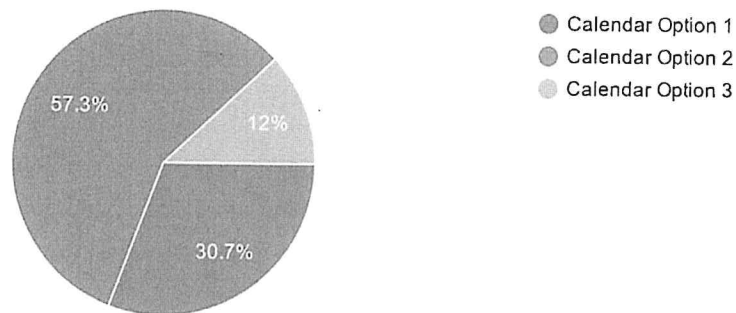

ADMISSION POLICY FOR HOMELESS, MIGRATORY, IMMIGRANT, FOSTER CARE AND ENGLISH LEARNERS

Pursuant to the requirements of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act, Plyler vs. Doe, 457 U.S. 202, (1982), Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, and the McKinney- Vento Homeless Education Act of 2001, all homeless, migrants, immigrants, foster care and English learners must have equal access to the same free appropriate public education, including public preschool education, provided to other children and youth. This shall be the policy of the Sumter County School System. Such children will be provided the opportunity to meet the same challenging state content and state student performance standards to which all students are held without being stigmatized or isolated.

The enrollment of homeless, migrant, immigrant, foster care and English learners shall not be denied or delayed due to any of the following barriers:

- Lack of birth certificate
- Lack of school records or transcripts
- Lack of immunization or health records
- Lack of proof of residency
- Lack of transportation
- Guardianship or custody requirements
