Purpose: To provide a one-time college scholarship of \$500 to an eligible senior (first year college student) from Woodland High School.

Award: One (1) non-renewable scholarship will be awarded.

Eligibility:

1. Applicant must be a senior at Woodland High School.
2. Applicant must have at least a 3.0 GPA (unweighted)
3. Applicant must demonstrate at least 90% attendance.
4. Applicant must demonstrate involvement within the school and community.
5. Applicant must be graduating from Woodland High School in June 2022.
6. Applicant must show proof of enrollment from the college or university they intend to enroll at in **Fall 2022**.
7. Applicant must submit ALL completed materials by the deadline **(Friday, May 20, 2022)**.

Application: *Please submit the following documents in a sealed envelope.*

1. Scholarship application
2. Scholarship essay
3. Two (2) letters of recommendations from WHS educators
4. Proof of enrollment to the college/university being attended

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: Essays and recommendation letters **must be typed**, double-spaced, in 12-point Times New Roman or an equivalent font, with numbered pages and one-inch margins.

ESSAY PROMPT:

In 500 words, write an essay in English responding to the following topic: Describe how your heritage, family, and the community in which you grew up have impacted your desire and motivation to obtain a college degree. Additionally, be sure to include what you intend to accomplish with your degree and how you will give back to your community.

Please submit the completed application and materials in a sealed envelope to Guidance Counselor no later than **Friday, May 20, 2022**. (Late applications will not be considered)
