- 4. Applicant must demonstrate involvement within the school and community.
- 5. Applicant must be graduating from Woodland High School in June 2022.
- 6. Applicant must show proof of enrollment from the college or university they intend to enroll at in **Fall 2022**.
- 7. Applicant must submit ALL completed materials by the deadline (Friday, May 20, 2022).

In 500 words, write an essay in English responding to the following topic: Describe how your heritage, family, and the community in which you grew up have impacted your desire and motivation to obtain a college degree. Additionally, be sure to include what you intend to accomplish with your degree and how you will give back to your community.
