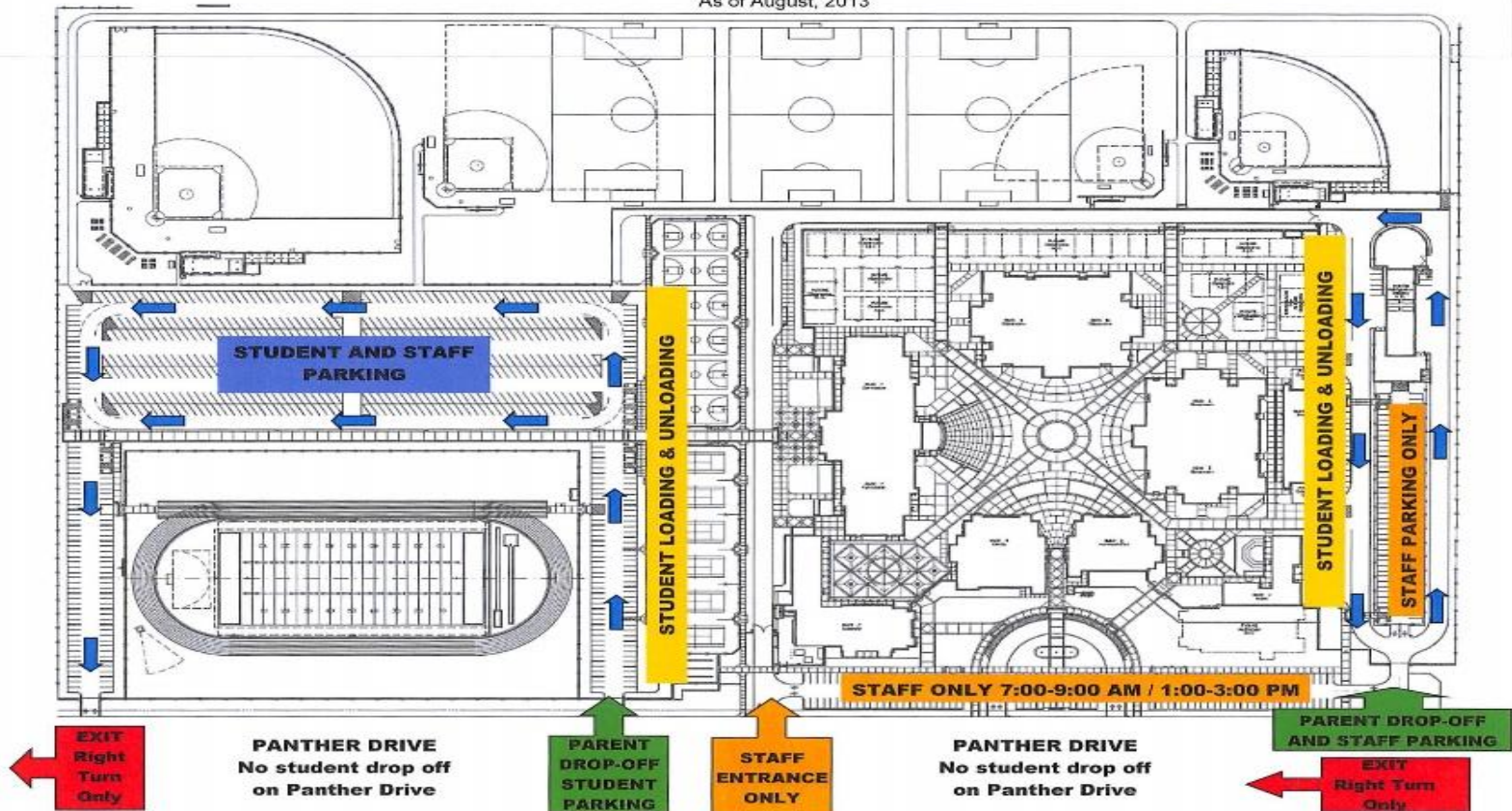

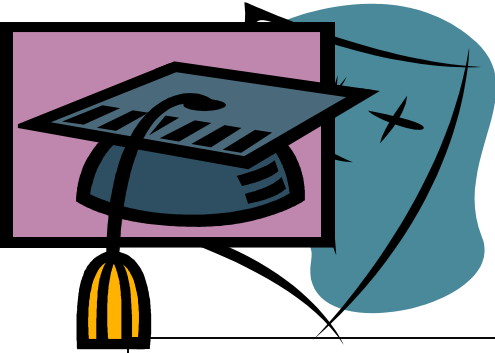

HOW PVHS REDUCES TRUANCY RATES:

- ▶ Guidance Tech's check daily absence lists and make random phone calls home to parents.
- ▶ GT's meet with students and notify parents at level one of **truancy**
 - ▶ 3 days or 18 period un-excused absences
- ▶ PVHS follows the SARB process and works closely w/ the SB County District Attorney office:
 - ▶ Administrative Meeting @ 36 period cuts
 - ▶ SARB- District/County meeting @ 72 period cuts

Ways PVHS reduces truancy and tardies

- ✓ Community Liaison will do home visits on truants.
- ✓ Tardy sweeps are done by security to minimize students late to class or cutting class.
- ✓ Parking lots are off limits for students during class, breaks, and lunch time.
- ✓ Attendance of Athletes is monitored by AD and AP for extra-curricular participation.


In general- Students take 6 classes per semester or 12 classes per year.

IF you FAIL a course, one of your electives the following year may be a Credit Recovery class during the school day to retake the failed class(es).

Credit Recovery classes are completed on-line with a teacher facilitating the learning.

If you become 30 or more units credit deficient, you may be recommended for the Alternative Ed school site - DELTA High School.

- ▶ PVHS has 10 security personnel, 5 Administrators, 10 Counselors, over 125 Teachers, and over 100 support staff on campus daily.
- ▶ If your child feels un-safe for ANY REASON, have them seek out a school employee immediately please.

 - ▶ Ed. Code permits a search of a student locker or backpack/bag in cases of reasonable suspicion of drugs, weapons or stolen property.
 - ▶ Students may be cited by SMPD in cases of a non-mutual fight, possession of drugs, weapons, or stolen property.

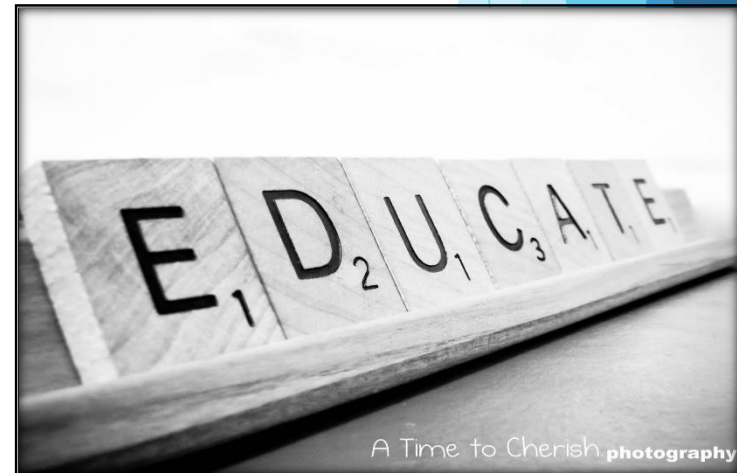

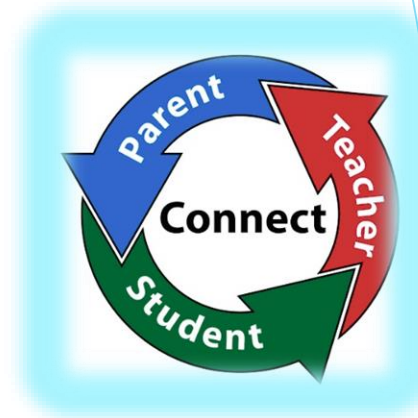

* Football players must complete the 5 day acclimation period. Acclimation period can begin no earlier than July 25.

* No individual shall participate in an interscholastic scrimmage before his/her 10th day of practice for that particular school. A team can schedule a scrimmage on the tenth day of practice.

* There shall be no football games until the team has had 14 days of practice. Each individual student on the team must have had at least 10 days of practice prior to competing in a game.

NOTE: Prior to competition a student must have 10 days of practice in that sport. If they played a sport in the preceding season they only need 5 days of practice.

Definitions:

Summer Period The "summer period" will vary from school to school as this period begins the day after your school's last day of classes in the spring and lasts until the day before your first day of classes in the fall.

All activities during this time period shall be under the authority of each school district with the exception of the mandatory consecutive 14 day dead period.

**Football - contact practices are not allowed in the offseason (CIF Bylaw 2001.C , CA Ed Code 35179.5, AB 2127)

Off-Season or Outside Agency Programs must choose between utilizing the off-season option or outside agency option.

Summer Dead Period Each program must choose 14 consecutive days during the summer period in which there will be no contact between coaches and student-athletes.

Beginning in the summer of 2023 the 14 consecutive days must be the same for all sports on each campus.

Practice Start Date First allowable day to begin practice.

First Contest Date First allowable day for interscholastic competition.

Sit-Out Period Date The date that a student may participate in competition after being granted a "SOP" due to transferring.

Last League Contest Date This is the last date that a league can schedule contests prior to playoffs.

Athletic Physical required to participate in Sports

- ▶ Physicals must be updated and good for one calendar year
- ▶ Physicals are provided each spring for free here on campus.
- ▶ Families can of course always go to their primary physician if needed.

- ▶ DRAGONFLY APP will be used by PVHS Athletics to track all paperwork electronically
- ▶ Student athletes and parents should download the APP and complete the necessary info
- ▶ No current physical on file = NO Participation
