The Vaccines for Children (VFC) program is a federally-funded program which provides vaccines free of charge to children 0-18 years of age who qualify for the program. Your local health department and medical provider may be enrolled in the program. These providers can offer vaccinations to children who are Medicaid eligible, uninsured or have health insurance that does not cover the cost of any or all vaccines. *Underinsured children have private (commercial) health insurance but the coverage does not include all (or selected) vaccines, or children whose insurance coverage caps at a certain amount.
