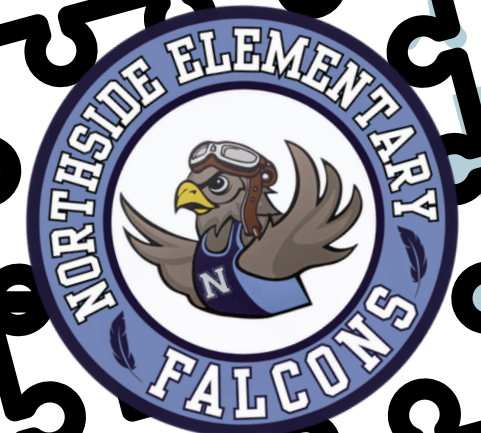

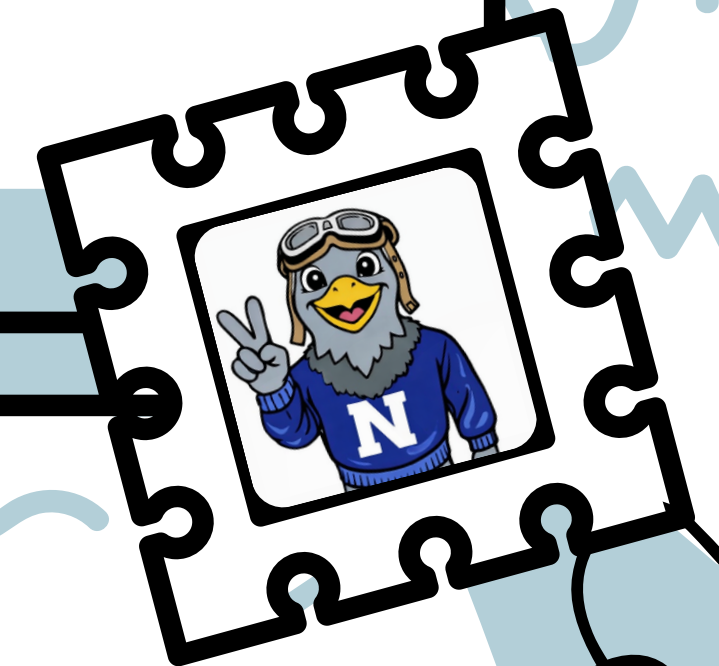
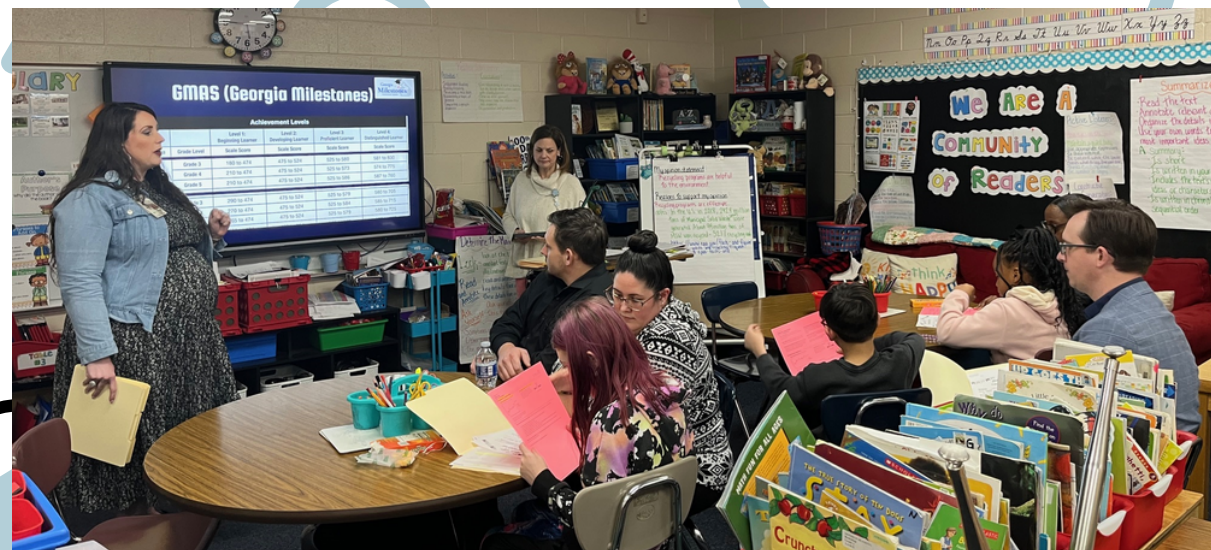
A GLIMPSE AT FAMILY ENGAGEMENT AT NORTHSIDE

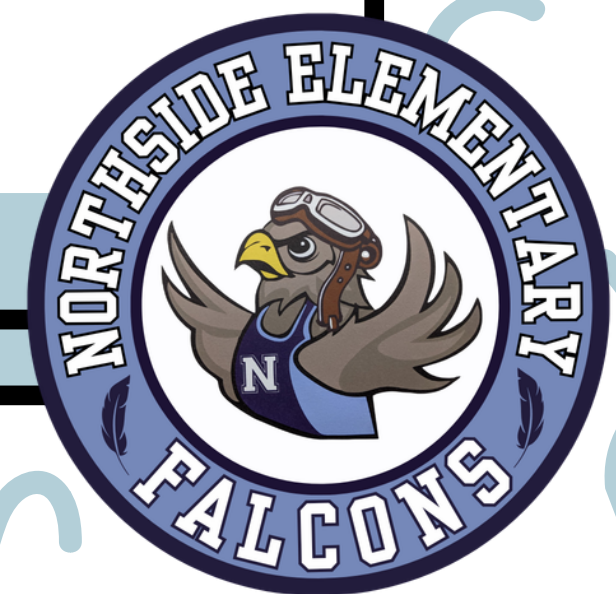

19% of you voted to improve the Family Resource Center at the school.



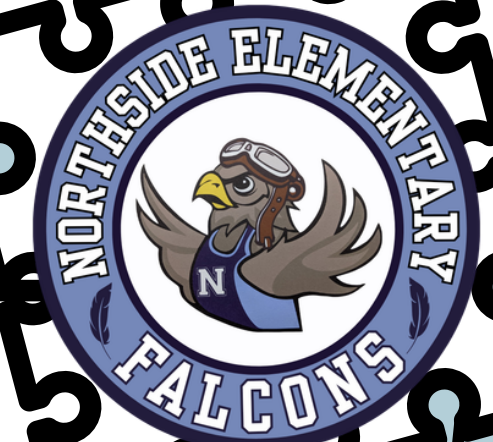
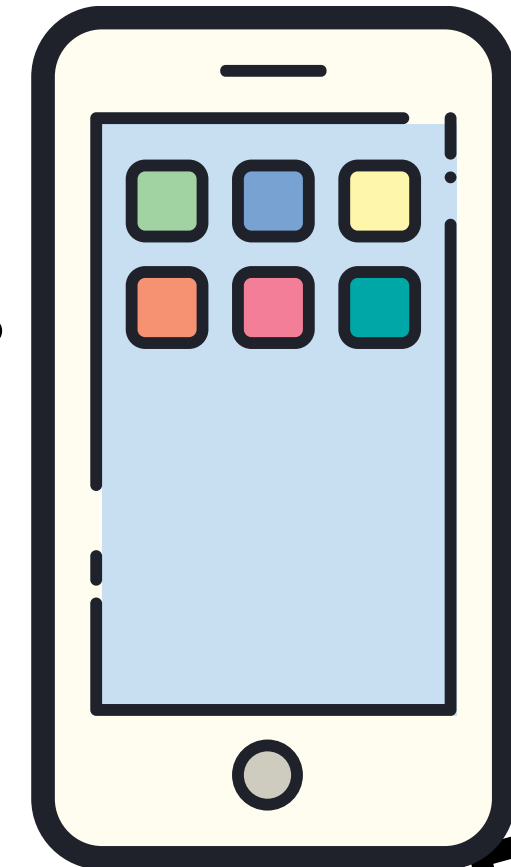

- Build and sustain a positive, strong culture to support the whole child, create an effective learning environment, and increase the number of students attending positive behavior celebrations and practicing social-emotional skills
- Provide workshops and events that increase family involvement as a partner in our children's education.

Northside Elementary will:

- Provide (2) math manipulative games for parents to practice fluency at home with their student.
- Provide 2 leveled texts for parents and students to read weekly.
- Provide a writing checklist for each writing unit for parents to utilize to help their students on different genres of writing.
- Provide family engagement academic events.

Family will:

- Spend time every week playing math games with their child.
- Read with their child every night and using the 2 leveled texts.
- Spend time weekly helping their child practice the skills on the writing checklist.
- Attend family engagement academic events.

Student will:

- Play math games at home to improve math fluency for multiplication.
- Build fluency and comprehension by reading the 2 leveled texts provided.
- Practice and correct writing skills by using the provided writing checklist when doing any kind of writing.
- Remind family to attend events.

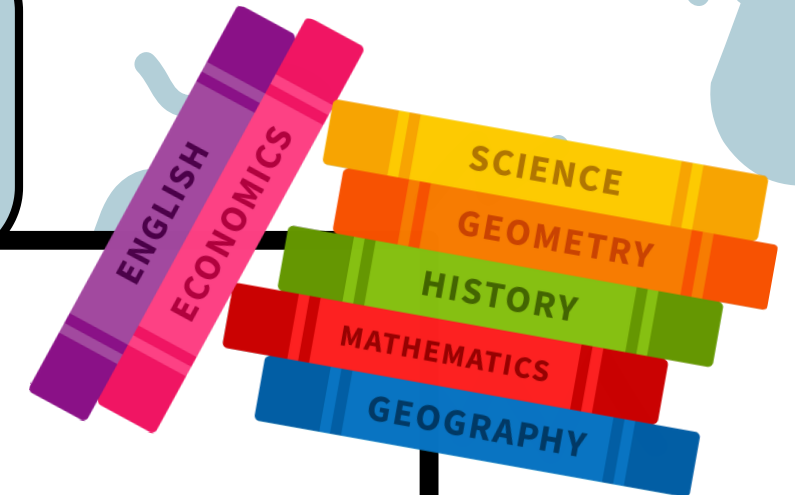
