COVID-19 TESTING FOR RIVENDELL INTERSTATE SCHOOL DISTRICT

<u>Cases of any symptomatic students or</u> staff

Anyone developing symptoms while at school will be assessed by the school nurse on a case-by-case basis. If sent home, individual(s) may return with IMPROVED symptoms and 2 negative antigen test results taken 24 hours apart.

Student or staff tests positive

- → Stays home and isolates for 5 days
- → Can return to school after Day 5 when
 - If never had symptoms, or symptoms have improved, and they feel better
 - AND has had no fever for at least 24 hours without the use of medicine that reduces fevers

Symptoms: remain home until 2
negative antigen test results taken
24 hours apart, or a negative PCR
test result, and symptoms
improved.

Symptoms include, but are not limited to sore throat, headache, cough, congestion, fever, vomiting, diarrhea, sneezing, runny nose.

Contract Tracing

Per state guidance we will no longer contract trace in our schools. If a positive case is identified, we will continue our notification only practice to families/staff. If you are notified and interested in obtaining a test you will need to contact the school.

In the event your student is sick and needs to be picked up from school please be certain that someone on your contact list is available.
