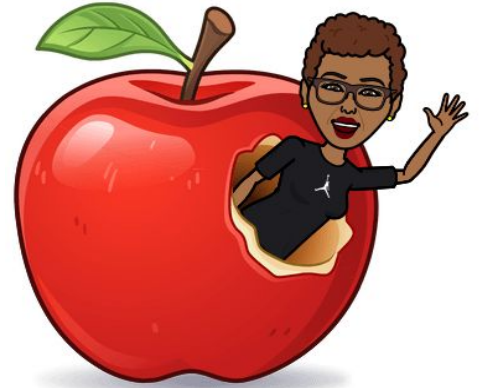

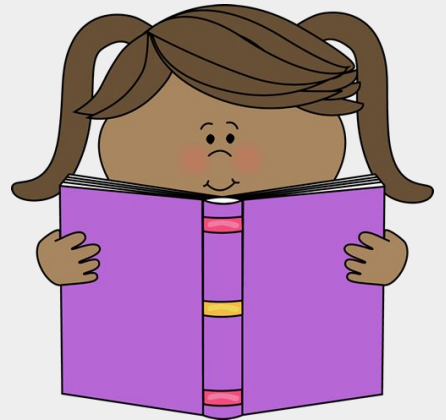

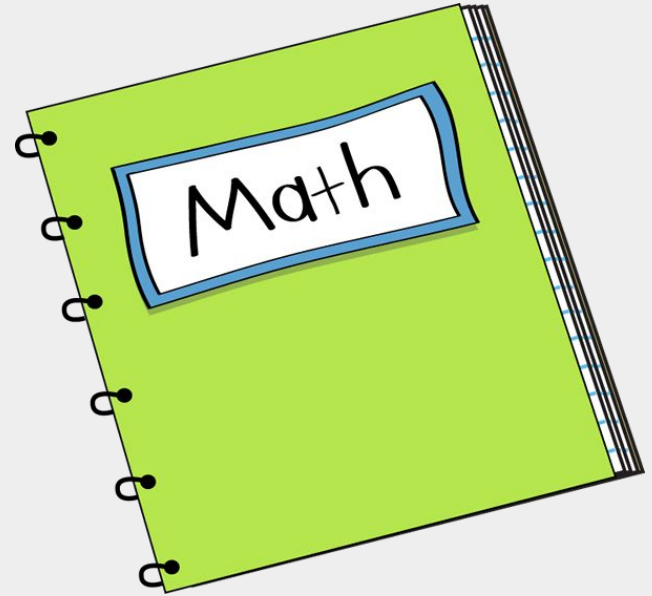
- Conferences are being conducted through Zoom

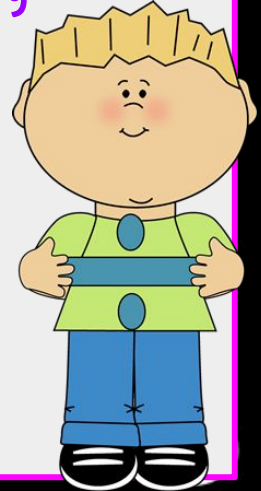

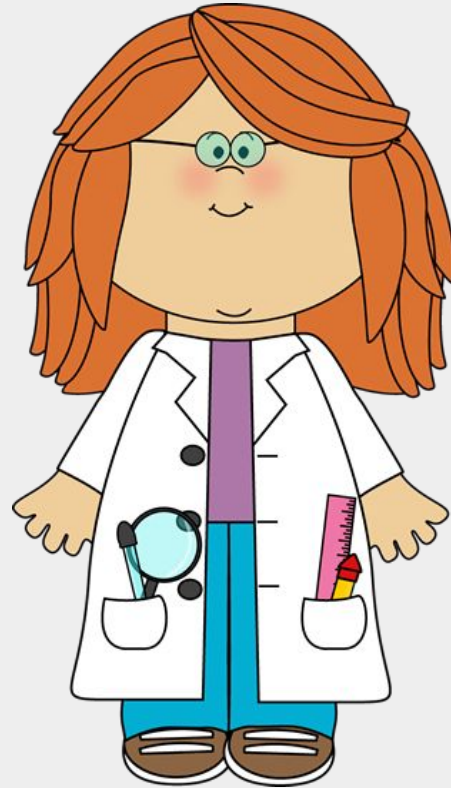
Writing

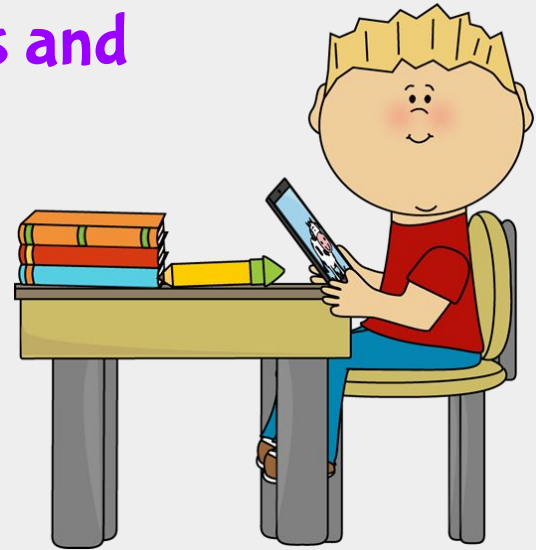

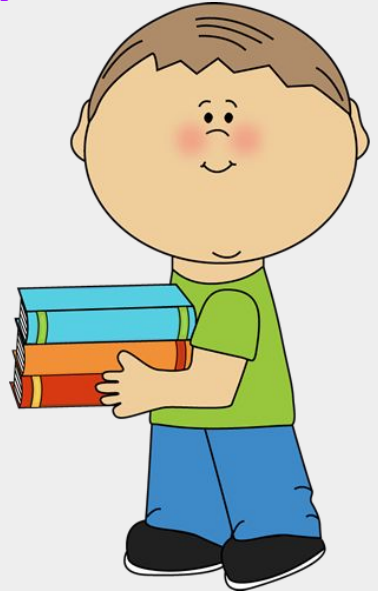
4th Grade Milestone

- Computer based so typing skills are important
- Taken at the end of the year
