

Mrs. Broadway's and Mrs. Woods' 3rd Grade Discipline Plan 2026-2027

In our classroom, we always work hard so that each child has an opportunity to learn in the best setting possible. This type of setting, in turn, enables every student to become the finest they can be! The students are learning how to be good team members in our classrooms, as well as in the entire school. To ensure each student is in the learning environment he or she deserves, we have developed the following criteria for maintaining a productive classroom climate.

The following point system will be in effect for the 2026-2027 school year. We encourage you to sign up for Parent Square, and make sure you keep the app updated on a regular basis to ensure that you are receiving regular communication with your child's teacher.

Each class session, your child will begin with 4 points. If a student chooses to break a rule or exhibit bad behavior, the following consequences will take place:

1st point lost from behavior issue - A verbal warning and the student will sign the behavior clipboard.

2nd point lost from behavior issue - Recess detention and the student will sign the behavior clipboard.

3rd point lost from behavior issue - Silent lunch and the student will sign the behavior clipboard.

4th point lost from behavior issue - A notification will be sent to parents via Parent Square. The student will sign the behavior clipboard.

Points lost within a semester for habitual behaviors:

Loses all 4 points two days= parent-teacher phone conference

Loses all 4 points three days= parent-teacher-admin phone conference

Loses 4 points four days= office referral submitted to admin for consequences

Students will participate in Fun Friday each week. If a student has lost 4 or less points throughout the week, then he/she will be able to participate in the entire Fun Friday. If a student has lost between 5-7 points throughout the week, a 10-minute timeout will be given. If a student has lost 8 or more points throughout the week, Fun Friday will not be rewarded and the student will serve detention during that time.

The purpose of this system is to create a positive classroom environment and to encourage your child to exhibit positive behavior throughout the day. Please understand that negative behaviors impede the learning of others, especially your child, and we want to make this system as fair as possible for everyone. This system has been agreed upon by the teachers and administration, and it will be fully enforced beginning August 11, 2026. It is vitally important that we work together in your child's education. A disruptive classroom is an unproductive one. This discipline plan has been very effective for students and results in positive behavior, better attention, responsibility, and more successful students. Thank you for your support!
