## ★ SUPPORTING YOUR STUDENT AT HOME

By now, students should be fluent with addition and subtraction within 10. If you child is still struggling with their addition and subtraction facts to 10, a deck of flashcards would be helpful! Show the cards and have them answer the equation in 5 seconds. If they don't get the answer automatically, have them use a strategy to solve .

## ★ OUR LEARNING

- Reading-Drawing inferences; using text features; asking and answering questions about the text
- Phonics- CVCe words with long O and long A; soft c and g; our and ow
- Writing: Composing a complete sentence independently; explanatory writing; different sentence types; contractions; pronouns
- Math- Addition and subtraction within 20 using strategies; place value within 100; comparing numbers; 1 more and 10 less
- Science/Social Studies- technology/planning and building robots
