Love never fails...



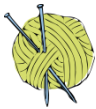
RCIA Considering joining the Catholic Church or know someone who may be interested? Catholic but never confirmed? Need to make your First Communion? Want to be baptized?

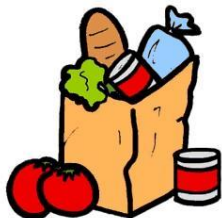


SVDP MEETING: SVdP will meet after the 10:00 Mass on Sunday, February 6th.
