Superintendent Nehermeyer shared with the Board the carpet project will start May 22nd the day after school ends and will end about mid-June. Gym flooring is rolling, having a vendor come to quote the district.

8. Superintendent's Report

Superintendent Nehrmeier shared with the Governing Board that the Oracle Schools Foundation Gala Fundraiser, held on March 14, 2026, was a great success.

She also reported that the Final Mile 5G internet tower Community Meeting was held on March 30, 2026, at Mountain Vista School Cafeteria. Superintendent Nehrmeier shared that there was a great turnout, with Mrs. Crall and Mrs. Barczak in attendance. She asked for their thoughts on the meeting, and they both stated it was very informative and that many questions were answered.

Superintendent Nehrmeier also shared that Pinal Central News reported Oracle School District had the largest increase in instructional spending, with an increase of 2.5 points. She explained that new curriculum was purchased for the 2025–2026 school year.

She discussed with the Governing Board that the main part of state testing was held from Monday, March 30 through April 10. She emphasized the importance of state testing for Arizona schools and reported that the main portion of testing has been completed, with makeup testing scheduled to be finished by the end of the week on April 17, 2026.
