

# **EMERGENCIES AT EVALINE SCHOOL**

**We must have the correct telephone numbers for the homes and places of employment of parents/guardians.** We also need neighbors and /or emergency contact names and numbers in case we cannot reach you. If we are not provided emergency contacts and if we cannot locate you, we will take emergency action, including transporting to an emergency room or calling for paramedical assistance.

In the case of unplanned early dismissals due to emergencies, students will be transported home unless we have special instructions in writing stating otherwise. This would include instances of sudden loss of power, water, or accumulation of snow.

**In the event of snow, ice or other inclement weather conditions it may be necessary to adjust the school starting time or cancel classes. In these kinds of situations please listen to your local Radio Stations and News Channels. We try very hard to make decisions by 6:30 a.m. Once the decision is made it is posted to the Flash Alert web site and sent to all local TV and Radio Stations. You can also go onto flashalert.net and check for delays and closures. If you want to have alerts sent to you by email or text, please follow the directions below. If you DO NOT hear any information regarding Evaline School you must assume school will be in session.**

## **How to Sign up for Email Alerts and Cell Phone Text Alerts:**

### **Flash Alert Email Only Alerts:**

1. Go to [www.flashalert.net](http://www.flashalert.net)
2. Hover over the “**View Local News**” tab at the top of the page
2. A list of areas will drop down, Choose “**Seattle/Western Washington**”
3. Select “**Lewis County Schools**”
4. Select “**Evaline School**”
5. Type in “**Your email**”
6. Check the “**Emergency Alerts**” box
7. Click “**Subscribe**”
