

2022-2023 FACULTY DRESS CODE

DRESS

All staff members are required to dress in a professional manner.

Professional dress that positively reflects the school must be worn to all school- related functions and events, both on-campus and off-campus.

- Pants with holes in them are not considered professional attire and are not allowed.
- Hats/Ballcaps may be worn outside for protection but are not allowed to be worn inside the buildings.
- T-shirts worn during school hours are not considered professional attire and are not allowed. T-shirts that support a school activity or sport are allowed during approved events.
- Earrings must be worn in earlobes only. For safety reasons, no other body piercings with rings or other jewelry is allowed.
- For safety reasons, no tongue rings will be allowed.
- Flip flops, crocs, backless shoes, and slides are not allowed.
- Sweat suits and wind suits are not allowed (except for P.E. Coaches-must be professional).
- Tank tops, low-cut shirts, sleeveless shirts, and clothing that reveal undergarments are not allowed.
- Shorts are not allowed for anyone.
- Inappropriate application of make-up, hair color, or hair cut that appears to be costume in nature is not allowed.
- Tattoos deemed to be inappropriate or unprofessional by the administration must be covered.
- Leggings, jeggings, and meggings are not allowed.
- Jeans of any color are not allowed.
- Dresses and skirts must be knee length.
