The first school day (Wednesday, Sept 6th) will be an early dismissal day. Full day sessions will begin on Thursday, September 7, 2023. We would again ask that when parents are dropping off children in the morning, please use the designated areas for drop off and pick up. This ensures the greatest level of safety for our students and staff.

Please assist us in the following:

- Students should be in good health in order to attend school. If your child is symptomatic of a communicable disease, please keep your child at home and contact your school nurse.
- Transportation is provided to eligible students and the safety of all students riding buses is of chief concern. Students are expected to adhere to all school rules and common-sense safety precautions while waiting for and riding on school buses. Students unable to adhere to these expectations may be removed from transportation.
- Students need to dress appropriately for school. Parents will be expected to sign the dress code on the first day of school ensuring that families will assist the school in adhering to the importance of proper dress during the school day and at all school events.
- Cell phones must remain **OFF** and out of sight at all times. If you need to contact your child, please call the main office at your child's school and we will provide access. Students will be allowed to make calls from the main office. **Students should NOT contact their parents from their own cell phones during the school day.**
