The District has \$29mln left from the Bond issuance that will be used for the 2-story structure at Santa Maria High School and the Performing Arts Center at Pioneer Valley High School.

- ➤ The Annual Audit will be posted to the SMJUHS website once finalized.
- > She will follow-up on whether or not it is advisable that the Bond Committee members are insured against lawsuits.

Pertaining to Santa Maria High School:

- > DSA (Division of State Architect) approval for Broadway classrooms at Santa Maria High School was received.
- \triangleright Project is out to bid with a deadline of 11/15/13.
- ➤ Commencement of construction is anticipated mid-December 12/16/13, and will include 14 classrooms in a 2-story structure (10 regular classrooms in the front; 4 larger classrooms in the back to make room for a piano and choir).
- ➤ Building has been designed to tie in with the Ethel Pope Auditorium and will include an elevator, solar power, LED lighting, soundproofing, etc.
- > Completion is expected in 16 to 18 months.
- A quarterly report will be provided to the Bond Oversight Committee.

Pertaining to Pioneer Valley High School:

- ➤ Performing Arts Center approval was sent to the DSA. Approval is expected in 6 to 8 months. Center will seat 294.
- > District employees are currently looking at document reviews.
- This project should be out-to-bid in 14-18 months.
