### STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

This week started District Benchmark Assessment. Students will take this test in January and again in March. This will be given like we give KSA to get 3<sup>rd</sup> thru 6<sup>th</sup> grade students ready for testing.

The culture and climate survey was taken earlier this week. We received a 70.5. There were a couple of survey questions with the word NOT that threw some students off. We need to make sure students have a clear understanding of the question. The testing window closes on Friday, January 27<sup>th</sup>. We should have the results within 72 hours. This test is very rigorous.

### POLICY REVIEW


