School Improvement Plans 2010-2012

School Calendar Recommendations 2012-2013

Mr. Trotter, Assistant Superintendent of Operations, presented a draft of the 2012-2013 school calendar. G. Cook, Board member, has served on the calendar committee. Mr. Trotter reviewed the calendar draft with 180 student days that does not begin before August 25. Teachers begin on August 17 with six workdays. The calendar has set open house dates with separate nights for each level school. Students return August 27 with last day June 7. The draft calendar will be posted on the web for public comments giving almost two months for public comments. The committee will meet again on Jan. 5 to review and will bring a final recommendation to the board on January 11, 2011 at the scheduled Board work session.

Improvement to Existing Facilities/Facility Needs Assessment

Mr. Trotter, Assistant Superintendent of Operations, presented a request from Wheatmore High Athletic Boosters to build a press box / concession stand between the baseball and softball field as well as add lighting to the softball field. G. Cook made a motion seconded by B. Coltrane to approve contingent on Mr. Trotter's approval. Motion carried: 7-0.

Facility Needs Assessment

Mr. Trotter, Assistant Superintendent of Operations, presented information regarding Facility Needs Assessment (Long-range plans). Mr. Trotter stated that every five years, local Boards of Education are required by North Carolina General Statute 115C-521(a) to submit long range plans to the State Board of Education. After discussion J. Johnson made a motion seconded by L. Williams to approve long-range plans to be submitted to DPI as follows: 0-5 years – Randleman area elementary school, a middle school in the A-T area, a new middle school in the Southwest area, and high school renovations; 6 – 10 years – New elementary school in the Eastern area, new middle school in the Randleman area and renovations of Ramseur Elementary and Braxton Craven. Motion carried: 7-0.

Randleman High School / Tiger Time

Mr. Trotter presented and reviewed a proposal submitted by Randleman High School to add an afternoon session to offer remediation and enrichment for students. He stated parents will be notified and will go into effect as soon as possible returning from Thanksgiving holiday. If a student needs remediation they would be required to stay. Those who do not may leave with parental consent. B. Coltrane made a motion seconded by G. Cook to approve the recommendation as presented. Motion carried: 7-0.
