#### Reports: Activities Report

From the Activity Director's Desk 5/13/2024

The Arts and Activities Awards ceremony took place on Wednesday May 15. Our community should be proud of the number of activities that WAO offers. Through the dedication of the advisors, coaches, and directors of the programs we offer, our students are able to grow their talents and show them off! Our girls track team won the section 8A True Team meet held in International Falls on May 7 and earned the right to compete at the state meet. The State True Team meet was held in Stillwater, Mn on May

Our girls performed well taking 3rd which is the highest any combination of girls teams made up of WAO and/or SAC have placed. Our girls track team continued with the success being crowned sub-section champions at the sub-section meet held in Ada on Tuesday, May 28. The fusion had competitors advance to sections in all 18 events! West-Marshall was also crowned section champions at the section 8A meet held in Glyndon, Mn on May 31. The Fusion had 8 athletes advance to the state meet with five being WAO students and three from SAC.

Fusion had 3 Golfers advanced to Sections which was held in Bemidji May 31 and June 1.

Boys basketball is on rotation for new uniforms for the 24-25 season. Money for uniforms comes from the W-club which is funded primarily through concession profits.

The gym is scheduled to be resurfaced June 28 - July 6.

Community Education has hired and Lily Bayne, Austin Wittman, and Tyson Mortimer to be the weight room supervisors this summer. Also through community ed. Zach Stene and Mason Wang will be running Speed and Strength at the school through community ed. The cost is \$100 per student. I am excited to see the weight room full in the mornings so far this summer! Hopefully it will continue.

JO volleyball is going strong as and has 6 teams: 10u with14 girls, 11u 10 girls, 12 u with12 girls, 14 u with 9 girls, 16 u with 9 girls, 18 has 9 girls. All in all JO will be in 31 tournaments this summer.

I am very excited that Summer Softball is taking off! We have three levels fielding teams; 8u with11 girls, 10u with 10 girls and 12u with 9 girls. They swept their first games with Warroad!

Due to our auditorium being under construction this fall we will have one gym for Volleyball. We are planning using the following schedule for our home games. Start times: 3pm 7th Grade, 4pm 8th Grade, 5pm C, JV and Varsity to follow.

I disappointedly report that the drain tiling of the softball fields has been pushed by the provider and now should take place at the end of June. The likelihood of having the field in shape with good grass lessons each week this project is delayed.
