	<p>Itawamba County School District will offer the TRADITIONAL classroom setting for the 2022-23 school year. ICSD will follow guidance from the Mississippi Department of Health and mandates from the governor.</p> <p><i>Hand sanitizers will be available in every classroom</i></p> <p>*Itawamba County School District may elect to offer limited durations of virtual instruction in the case of an emergency or high volume of sick students.</p> <p>*School visitors may be limited per recommendation of the MS Dept. of Health</p>
	<p>Hand sanitizer will be available on every bus. Students and bus drivers may wear masks or face coverings that follow the dress code while inside the bus.</p>
	<p>All cafeterias will be open and fully functional.</p> <p>*Covered or individually wrapped food items will be available when feasible.</p> <p><i>Hand sanitization stations will be available at each serving line.</i></p>
	<p>Masks, face shields, and face coverings will be optional.</p>
	<p>Itawamba County School District will follow all Mississippi High School Activities Association (MHSAA) guidelines as it pertains to athletics events and activities.</p> <p>*Per MHSAA, virtual learning students may not participate in athletics or activities.</p>
	<p><u>Quarantine Procedures:</u></p> <p>*Students and staff who have a positive COVID-19 test result will quarantine for 5 calendar days from the onset of COVID-19 symptoms. They must be fever-free for 24 hours prior to returning to school.</p> <p>*Students and staff will be required to bring a doctor's note for absences to be excused.</p> <p>*Students/staff who are close contacts WILL NOT be required to quarantine unless they develop symptoms and receive a positive test result.</p>
