3. Motion to approve:

- b. The emergency meeting of the board minutes for August 27, 2025, as presented, was made by David Walker, with a second from Chris Silva. Unanimous.

4. Discussion of the 2025-2026 proposed tax rate (\$0.666900).

5. Motion to approve the 2025-2026 tax rate: **"I move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.666900, which is effectively a 23.60% increase in the tax rate,"** was made by Richard Caldara, with a second from David Walker. Unanimous.

6. Discuss changes and impact to local, state and federal funding for the 2025-2026 school year.

This year's tax rate (0.666900) will raise more taxes for maintenance and operations than last year's tax rate. The proposed tax rate will effectively be raised by 2.70 percent and will raise taxes for maintenance and operations on a \$100,000 home by approximately \$0.00.

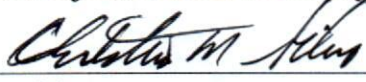

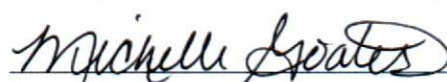
