BOARD OF TRUSTEES ANNUAL MEETING
MARCH 9, 2026 6:30P.M.
TROY HIGH SCHOOL LIBRARY**

1. **Call to Order:** Pam Hilliard called the Regular Meeting to order at 6:31 p.m.
 - A. Members Present:** Pam Hilliard, Kendra Holden, Daniel Moyer; Lisa Hunter, Wendy Fredrickson
 - B. Administrators Present:** Supt Klaira Vogt; HS Principal, Aaron Dail; Theresa Priebe, Clerk
 - Adopt Agenda:** By unanimous consent, the agenda was approved.
2. **Presentation:** Mr. Spence presented on the transition to integrated mathematics pathways with when it was implemented, where it is currently, and where it's going to go. The first full year of the integrated mathematics pathways will be the 26-27 school year. Integrated I, Integrated II and Integrated III are implemented with class proficiency at approximately 70%. Staff will be working on the Beyond Textbooks alignment so that the Beyond Textbook calendar will align with course scheduling.

4. **Approve Consent Agenda:** By unanimous consent, the Consent Agenda was approved. Items approved: Regular meeting minutes from February 9, 2016; Bills paid totaling \$401,674.33; Resignations from Elysia Patrick, THS Girls' Softball Head Coach.
5. **Information Items:** Budget reports included: February 2026 ASB budget reports; Food Service report; Medical Insurance Pool and District Financial report. Enrollment is currently 328. Principal reports: **THS – Student Achievement** – FFA State Convention will be in Twin Falls March 31-april 5, 2026; THS Cheer program competed at the State Cheer Competition February 28th placing 1st in Co-Ed Show and 3rd overall; White Pine All League Basketball Girls 1st team, Tessa Stoner and Boys Honorable Mention Evan Kirkham; State Mock Trials in Boise March 10-12; Students of the Month for March category is Responsible; **Communications** – FFA Community Breakfast, Elementary Expo, National Soils in Oklahoma City May 2-9; BPA State Convention, National BPA in Nashville, TN May 5-10; Spring sports began February 27th, Student Handbook committee will meet March 10 and March 17; Shakespeare Presentation March 13; Hope Week March 16-20; ISATS April 13-May 1; You're your Government Program was discussed and more information is needed to be gathered for credit consideration; Safety hold and evacuation was held February 27th; Parent Teacher conferences March 10th & 11th; formal observations ongoing. **Superintendent's report: Student Achievement**—Read Across America March 12; Math Pathway outcomes are problem solving and workforce readiness, BT calendar updated and this is the 3rd year of the integrated courses; Tech Committee needs to update the current filtering managed umbrella and safety management system to BlocksI because the current vendor is outpricing smaller districts; **Financial/Transparency** – Reducing budget by 3% and have met with teams, insurance is projected to increase up to 20% next year; Met with Kelly Scholarship Committee to review current process and application; **Facilities**— Fire Drill on February 26; and met via Zoom with Clearwater Power personnel to fully understand how the power grid is set up and to get Troy Schools on the list of priorities; **Communications**— Post Legislative Tour is scheduled April 14th at LCSC; Accreditation process completed; Parent Teacher conferences and Math Night on March 10 & 11; Reader Board presentation to Troy Recreation District and Troy Recreation District willing to pay up to 80% of the cost but no more than \$54,000 and community events will be posted per District policy; **Recruitment & Retention** – Safe School training, Amira training for Mrs. Heath and Mrs. Payne, regional superintendent meeting. Board Chair had no report.
6. **Action Items**
 - A. Approve School Closure February 18, 2026 and February 24, 2026:** Wendy Fredrickson moved to approve the school closure for February 18, 2026 due to adverse weather and the school closure on February 24, 2026 due to power outage. Daniel Moyer seconded. All voted aye. Motion carried.
 - B. Approve THS Jr High Boys' Basketball Head Coach:** Lisa Hunter moved to approve Guy Wells as junior high head coach for the 2025-2026 school year. Kendra Holden seconded. All voted aye. Motion carried.
 - C. Approve District Calendar for the 2026-2027 & 2027-2028 school years:** Lisa Hunter moved to approve the District Calendar proposals for the 2026-2027 & 2027-2028 school years. Kendra Holden seconded. All voted aye. Motion carried.
 - D. Approve Kelly Scholarship Process/Updates:** Daniel Moyer moved to approve the current changes to the Kelly Scholarship as presented. Kendra Holden seconded. Discussion on the topic included striking the 12 dual enrollment credits that high school seniors earn and to state that one year of college be completed to apply. Aye votes – 0; Nay votes – 5. Motion did not pass.

Wendy Fredrickson moved to approve the current changes to the Kelly Scholarship with the following changes as discussed: Requirements: Applicants have to complete one year of college or university to be eligible. Strike out "or a minimum of twelve (12) dual enrollment credits." And, on the Instructions and Application page – All persons who have graduated from Troy High

School shall be eligible to apply for scholarship funds. The intent is for students to have access to a scholarship to continue their education beyond the first year of post high school education.

Strike out "This shall specifically include past graduates, as well as members of the current graduating class who have completed a minimum of twelve (12) college credits by the application deadline." Lisa Hunter seconded. All voted aye. Motion carried.

E. Approve Reader Board: Lisa Hunter moved to go in partnership with the Troy Recreation District and approve the purchase of a new reader board to replace the existing sign by the park. Kendra Holden seconded. All voted aye. Motion carried.

7. Executive Session I.C. 74-206(1)(j)—Negotiations: Wendy Fredrickson moved to go into Executive Session per Idaho Code 74-206(1)(j) Negotiations at 8:27 p.m. Lisa Hunter seconded. A roll call vote was duly taken: Wendy Fredrickson-aye; Daniel Moyer-aye; Kendra Holden-aye; Lisa Hunter-aye; Pam Hilliard-aye. Motion carried.
