Operations

1. Recommendation to revise Board Policy 4400 - Attendance (First Reading)

Mr. Trotter, Assistant Superintendent of Operations, presented Board Policy 4400 first reading. M. Lambeth made a motion seconded by T. Cutler to approve the first reading of policy 4400 as presented. Motion carried: 7-0.

2. Recommendation to approve lease agreement for the use of transmitter space

The Board had discussion regarding the location, vendor, and the cost. Mr. Trotter stated the band frequency is 80% coverage for our county. With no further discussion, T. Boyles made a motion seconded by G. Mason to approve the lease agreement for the use of the transmitter space between the City of Asheboro and the Randolph County Board of Education. The term of the agreement shall be for ten (10) years. Motion carried: 7-0.

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3. Recommendation to revise school fees for the 2013-2014 school year

Mr. Trotter recommended a revision to the school fees for the 2013-2014 school year to include an increase to the Driver Education fee from \$45 to \$55 due to the reduction in state funding, and the removal of the \$10 computer fee for high school students. T. Cutler made a motion seconded by T. Boyles to approve the recommendation as presented. Motion carried: 7-0.

4. Recommendation to revise opening and closing times for the 2013-2014 school year

Mr. Trotter presented a revision to the opening time of Liberty Elementary from 8:00 a.m. to 7:50 a.m. and a closing time for Randleman High School from 3:20 p.m. to 3:05 p.m. G. Mason made a motion seconded by M. Lambeth to approve the revisions as presented. Motion carried: 7-0.

The following action item is an addendum to the agenda for August 20, 2013.

- 5. Request to designate instructional houses at Eastern Randolph High School and Southwestern Randolph High School as surplus property and negotiate sale of such property.
- G. Mason made a motion to declare the instructional houses, and the real estate upon which they sit as surplus property, as they are unnecessary and undesirable for public school purposes, and authorize and instruct the staff to dispose of them using the methods for disposal of surplus property authorized by N.C.G.S. 115C-518, including the acceptance of a negotiated offer and upset bid process or auction or such other method as the staff deems prudent. The motion was seconded by E. Coltrane. The motion passed unanimously.
