What a beautiful September we had here in Boulder: clear skies, crisp mornings and beautiful fall colors starting to come out.

Parents: Please do not park in our designated bus loading zone. It is illegal in Montana to park in a designated bus loading/unloading zone, and you can be ticketed for it. This is the area south of our elementary playground along the north side of West 4th Avenue from the edge of the daycare parking lot to the corner of Monroe Ave and 4th Avenue. Our busses often come back around after the morning drop off to pick up for other school activities.

On Wednesday, October 8th, we are going to participate in National Walk-to-School Day. Students who want to, will gather with some of our high school students and Mr. Moodry, the high school principal, at the Boulder City Park, next to the Boulder City Building on Main Street at 7:45 AM and walk or hicycle to school. We are so thankful for our coaches and all the time they invest in our students. When you see your child's coach, thank them for all they do. They are the reason your kids have the opportunities that they do.

For Halloween, students from Kinder Cubs through the 5th grade will be having activities in the afternoon with their teachers. Costumes will be put on after lunch.
