History of the Statue: The statue was designed according to the specifications of Sr. Lucia, one of the three visionaries. On October 13, 1947—the thirtieth anniversary of Our Lady's final apparition to the three children in Fatima, Portugal—in the presence of about 150,000 pilgrims—the statue was blessed by the Bishop of Leira, Fatima, for the purpose of traveling the world and bringing the Message of Fatima to people everywhere. The Pilgrim Statue has traveled the world many times, visiting more than 100 countries, including Russia and Red China.

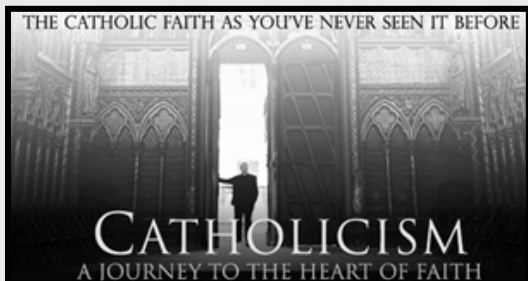
